AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Snabrough, broch, burnt mound and settlements, Unst, dated 24 May 1934 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the Counties of Orkney and Zetland on 22 August 1934 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as bounded on the S by the shore of the loch and on the W, N and E by straight lines measuring 70m, 170m and 90m respectively. The E and W boundary lines run due N-S. The area is indicated in red on the accompanying map extract as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.
