

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 2093  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Windhouse, broch 75m W of comprises a broch of Iron Age date, built probably between 500 BC and AD 200. The broch is visible as a large turf-covered mound, with a midden on the west side. The mound stands 3m high and measures about 17.5m in diameter. The monument lies about 40m above sea level, on the summit of a low hill. The area to be scheduled is irregular on plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The scheduling specifically excludes the above-ground elements of all post-and-wire fences, and the gate on the east side, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Yell and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto
