

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 2097  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St. Olaf's Church, church, enclosure and tombstones, 500m N of Wick comprises the remains of a small stone church dedicated to St Olaf, which sits within a rectilinear enclosure containing the remains of six upright cross-shaped stones and two 16th-century gravestones. The church dates probably from the 12th century and was abandoned by 1785. The site stands about 15m above sea level, 8m inland from the W side of Lunda Wick. The area to be scheduled is sub-rectangular on plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment may survive. The scheduling excludes all active burial lairs and all memorial stones erected after 1850, as well as the above-ground elements of all modern fences and stone dykes to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Unst and the County of Orkney and Zetland as shown in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

[REDACTED], is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

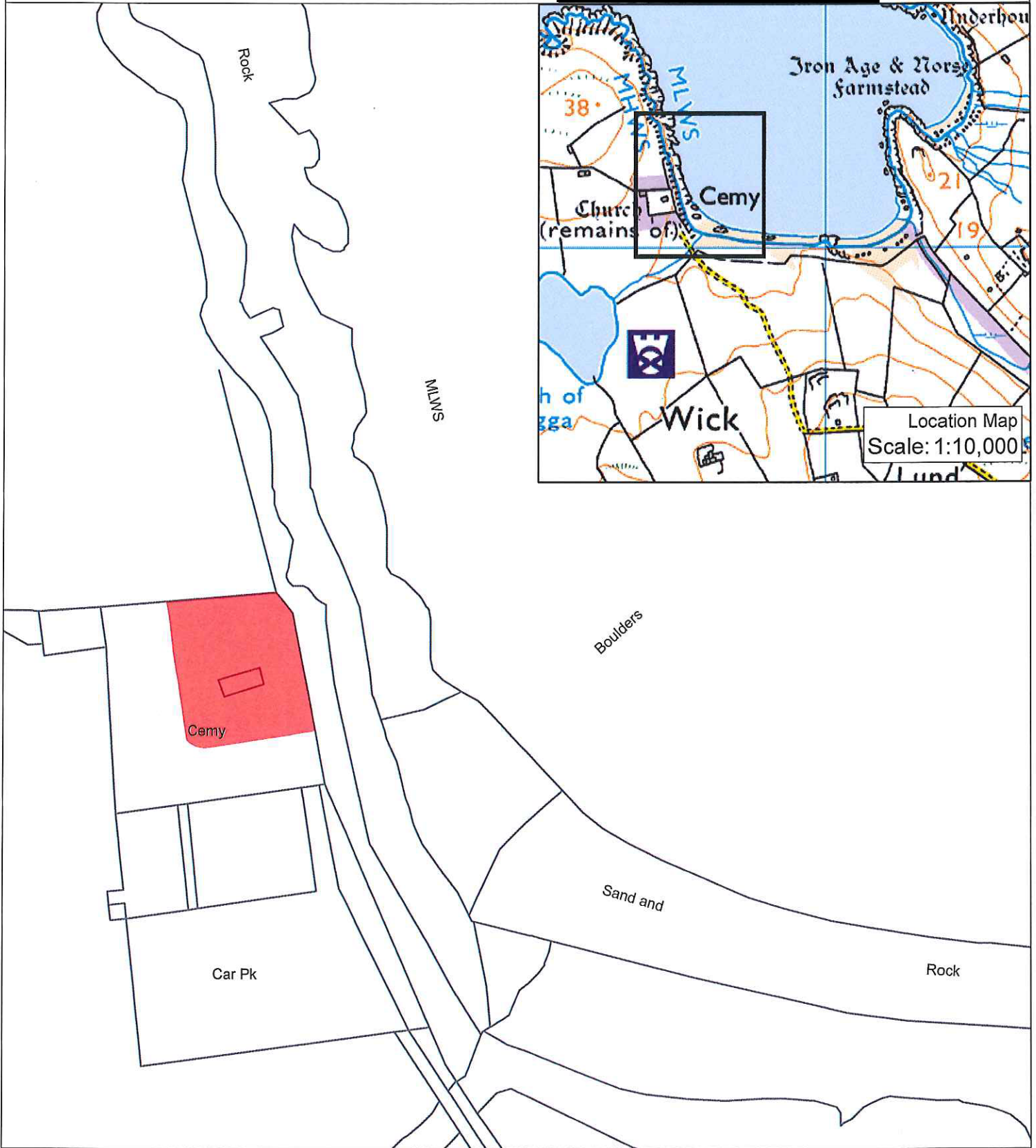
