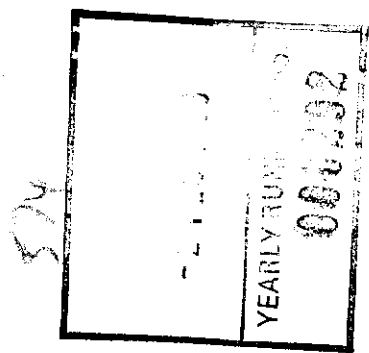



ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as St Olaf's Church, remains of church, Kirk Loch, North Yell comprises remains of the church of St Olaf. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains of the church and an area around extending 1.25m out from the outer wall face all around, giving a rectangular area 15m E-W by 9m, aligned from just N of E to just S of W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Yell and the County of Shetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.


