situated in the Parish of Cathcart

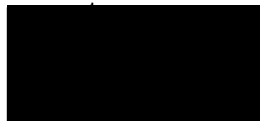

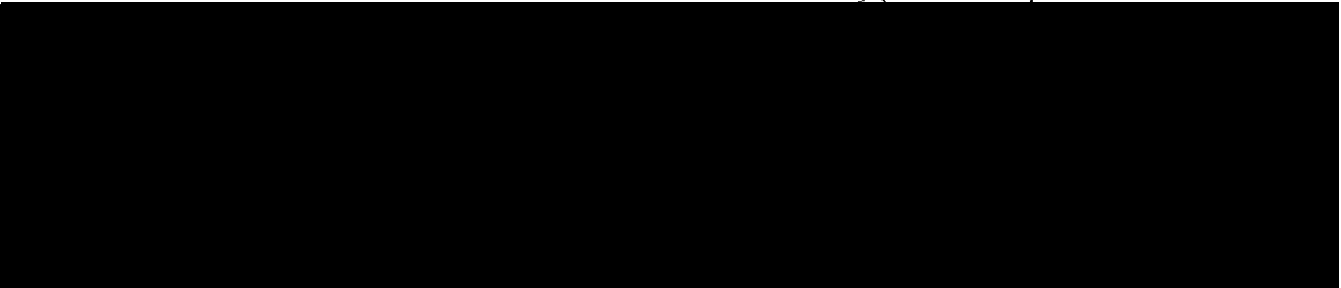
