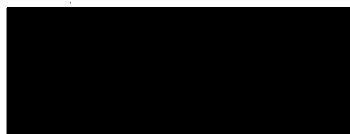

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Chapel (on site of broch), Rubh'an Teampuill, Toe Head dated 14 August and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Inverness on 13 September both in the year 1961 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as being irregular on plan, measuring up to 125m E-W by 120m N-S. It includes the chapel, the broch remains and the enclosure wall, and is defined on the W, S and E by the edges of the promontory, and on the N by a line drawn 10m N of the N side of the enclosure wall as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

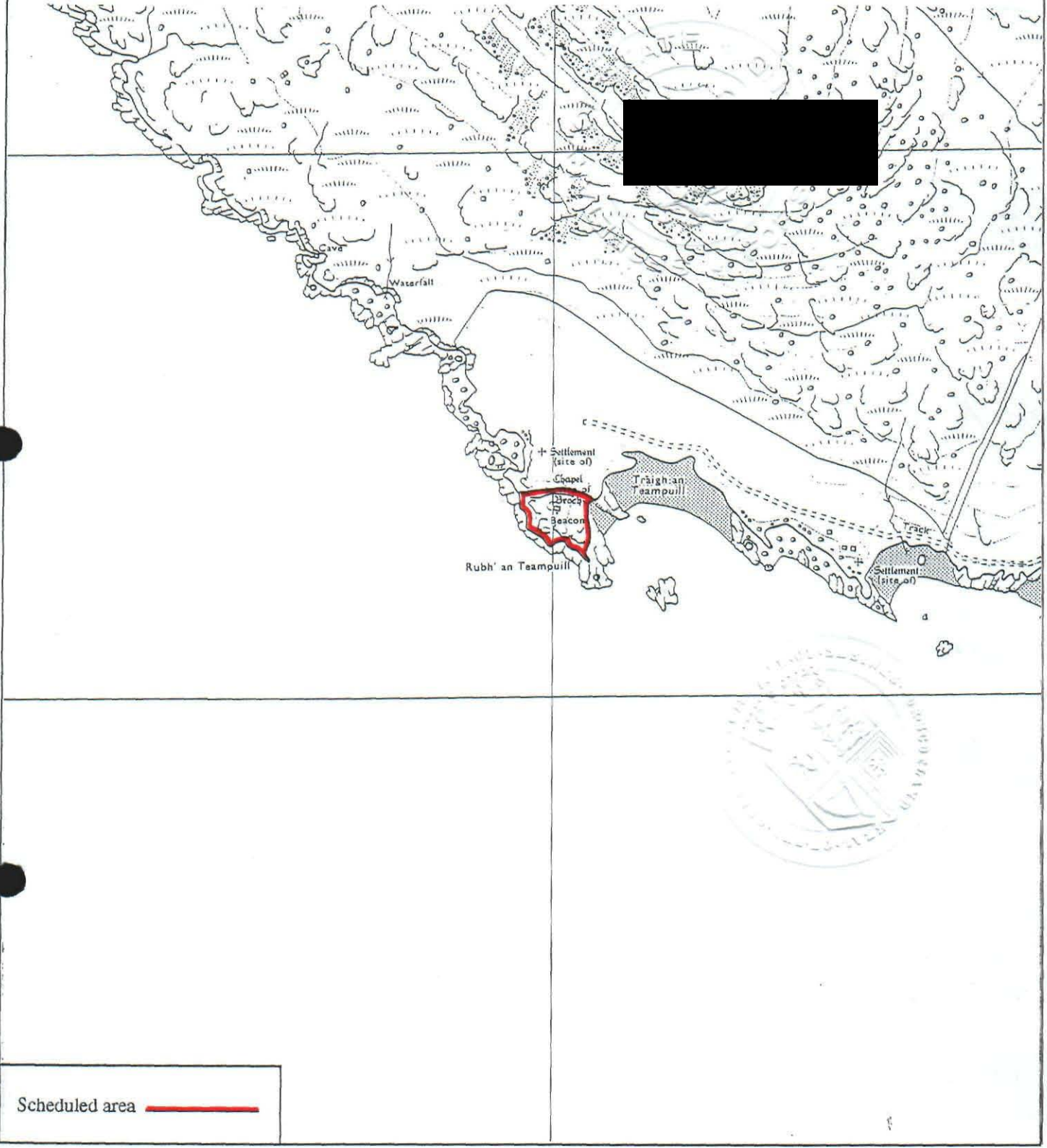


