The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Dumyat Fort, Blairlogie, now to be known as Castle Law, fort 400m SW of summit of Dumyat dated 21 December 1961 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Stirling on 22 January 1962 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as approximately oval and measuring 95m N-S by 150m E-W as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

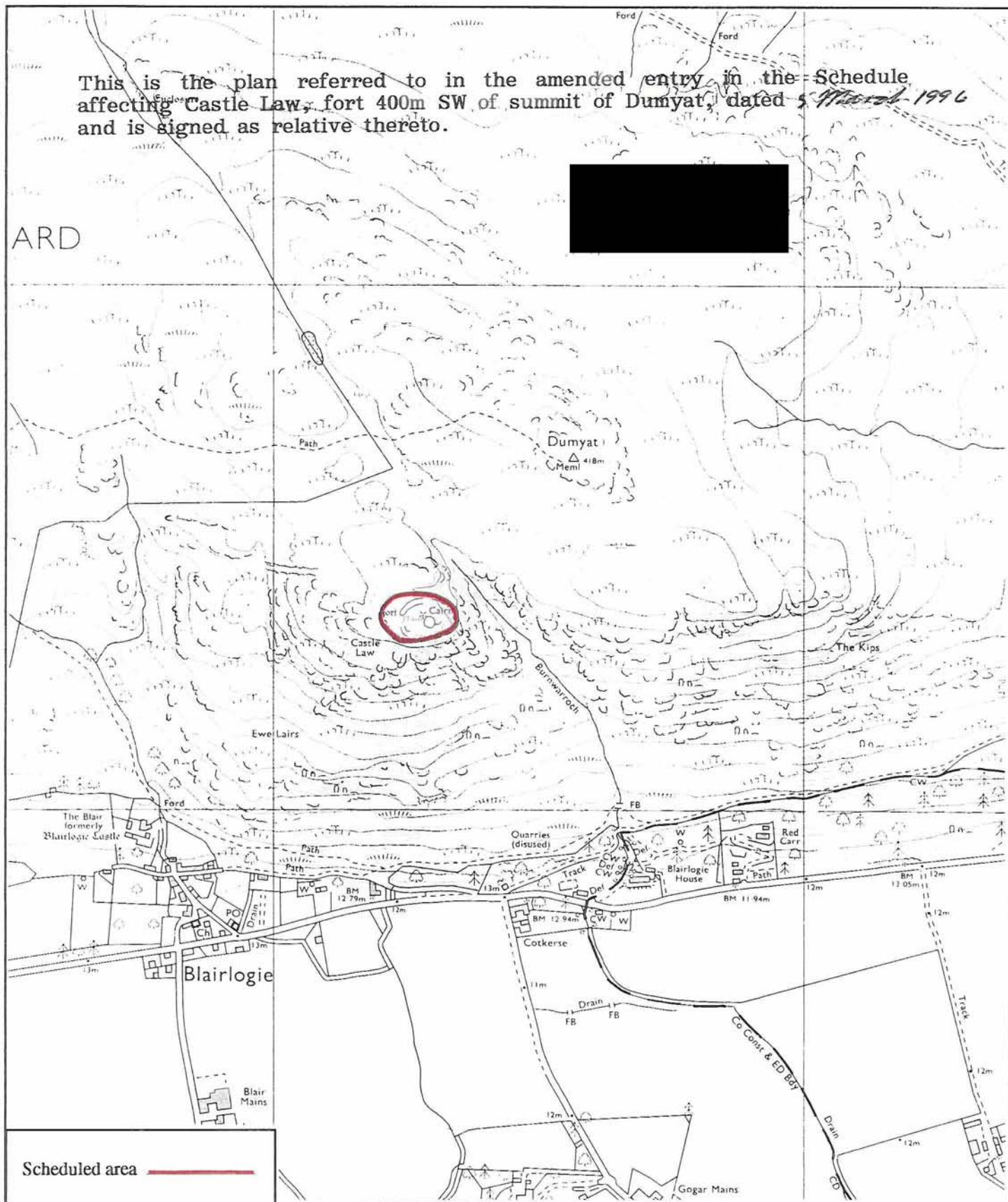

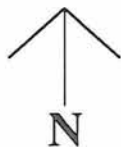

Scheduled area

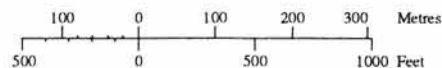
**Castle Law, fort 400m SW of summit of Dumyat**

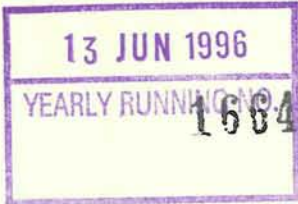
