AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as New Greenhill, fort, dated 6 February 1963 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Selkirk on 5 March 1963 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 180m NE-SW by 100m transversely, to include the visible remains of the fort, the probable rampart lines along the NW and SE sides and a small area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and use of the fort may survive, as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

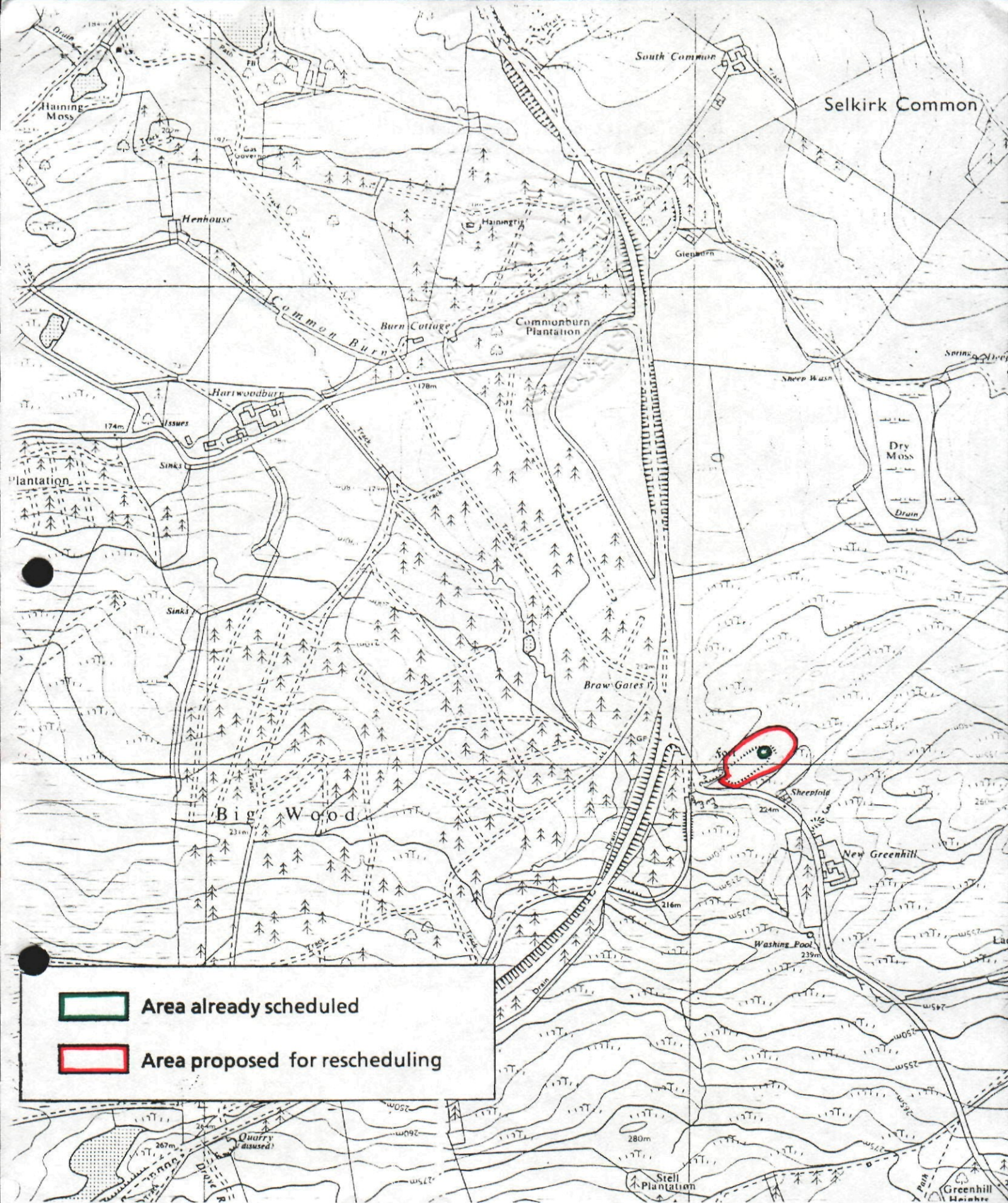

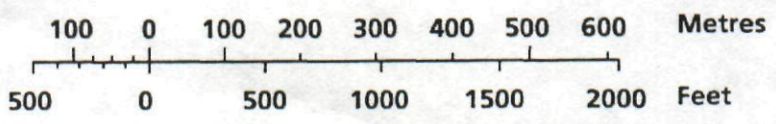
