

 recorded G.R.S. Roxburgh 27th January, 1951,

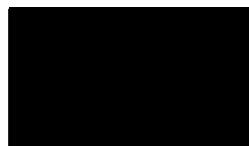

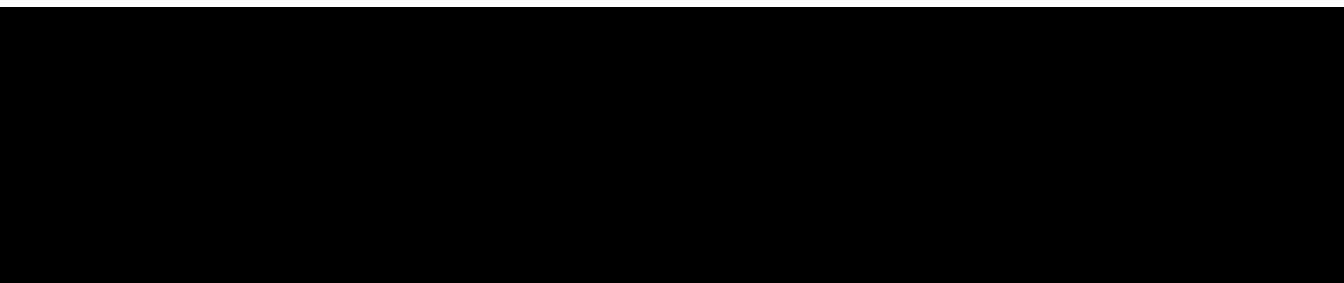
