

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Dun a'Gheird, dun, comprises the well-preserved remains of Dun a'Gheird, a fortified building of Iron Age date, visible as an upstanding structure. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material is likely to survive. It is irregular, with maximum dimensions of 77m NE-SW by 44m transversely. It is bounded on the E by the base of the cliff, but on the W extends to include the breadth of the adjacent gully, which may have served as an access route to the dun from the shore. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilfinichen and Kilvickeon and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

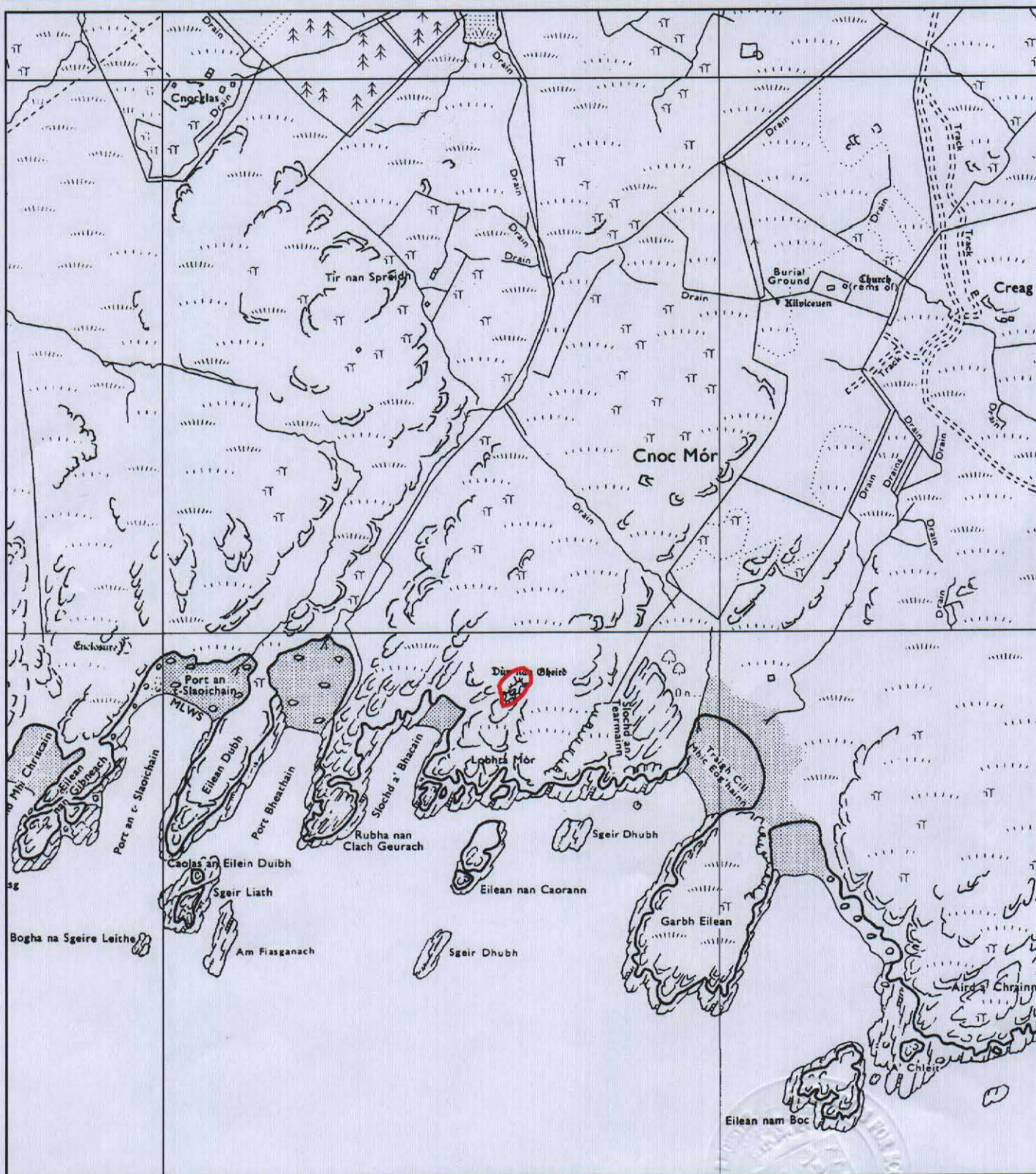

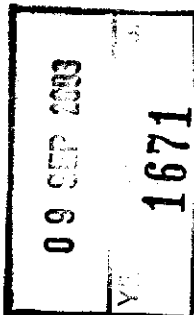
