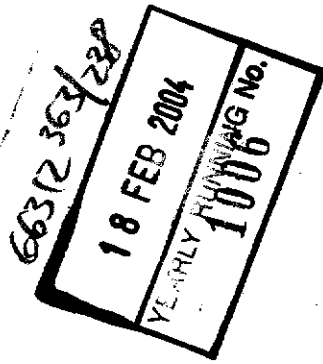

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Dundarg Castle, fort and castle, comprises Dundarg Castle, a medieval castle dating to the late 13th/early 14th century, constructed on the site of a prehistoric promontory fort. The area to be scheduled encompasses the castle, including outer ditch system, the outer ward and the inner ward on the promontory. Excluded from the scheduling is the modern house and garage, and the upstanding sections of the modern boundary walls. Also excluded is the top 30cm of ground surfaces beneath the roadway and the hard standings. The area is irregular and has maximum dimensions of 192m NNE-SSW and 194m WNW-ESE; the house and garage are shown as specific exclusions on the map marked by red lines within the boundary of the scheduled area. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Aberdour (Banff and Buchan) and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which

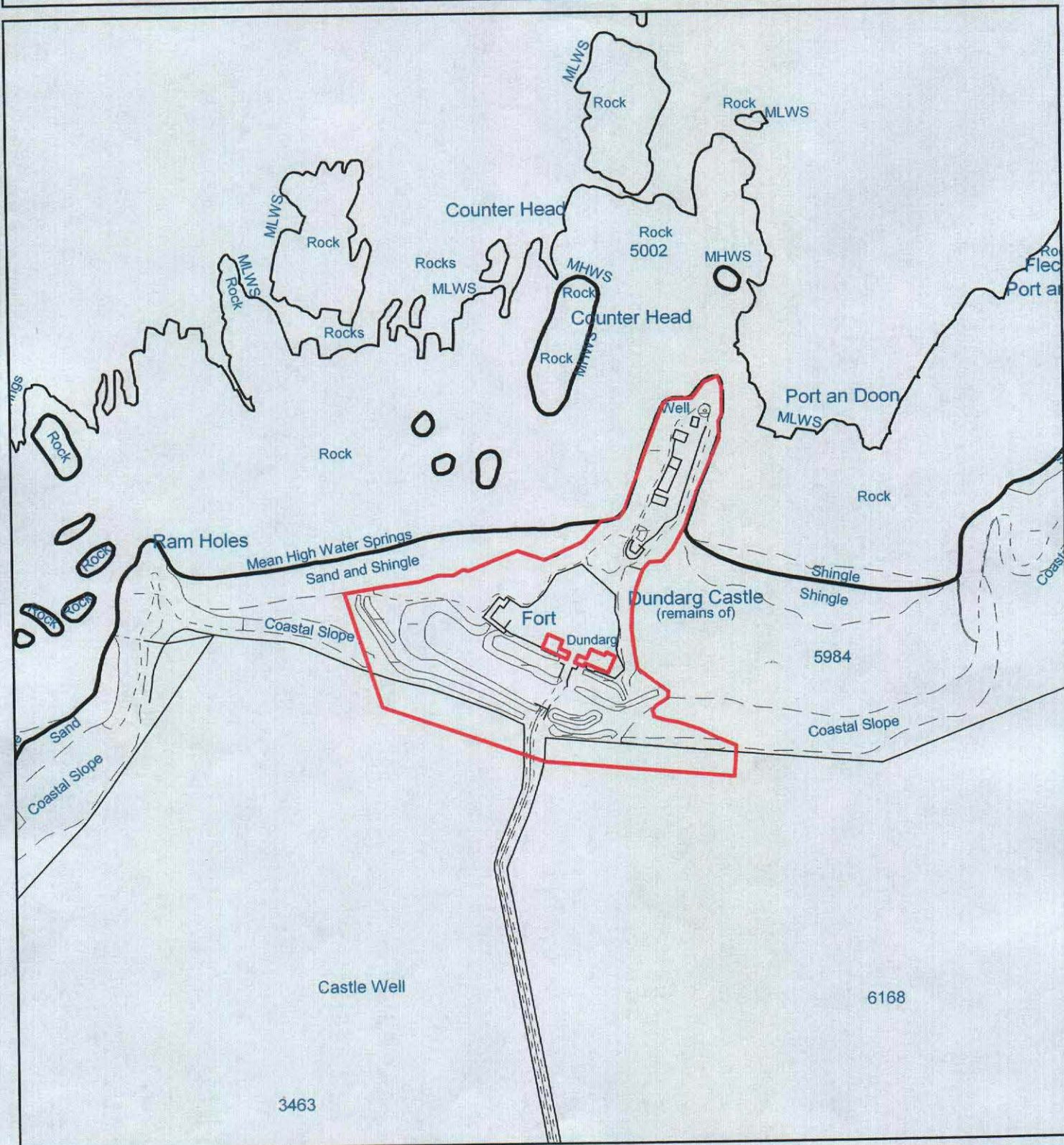

Scheduled Area

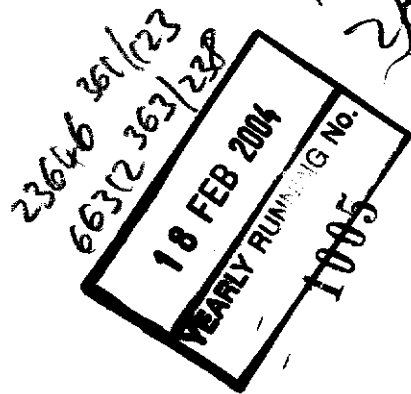
