THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Cramond, Roman fort and civil settlement, dated 11 August 1965 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Midlothian on 14 October 1965 [Book 12122 Folios 203, 205, 207, 211, 213, 215 and 217] is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 425m NW-SE by 435m NE-SW as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto. Surfaces and above ground elements of modern walls, field boundaries, paths, roads and car parking areas are excluded from the scheduling, as are all upstanding modern buildings and their immediate environs. In particular, exclusions include Cramond House and Tower, Cramond Church, Manse, Church Hall and burial ground and surrounding land, all as marked in red on the accompanying map extract.
