AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Keir Knowe, 500 yards W of Easter Glinns and NE of Mains of Glinn, dated 16 November 1966 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Stirling on 23 November 1966 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument now known as Keir Knowe, motte 460m W of Easter Glinns and the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 110m WSW-ENE by 65m SSE-NNW, to include the knoll and an area around in which traces of activities associated with the construction and occupation of the earthwork may survive, as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

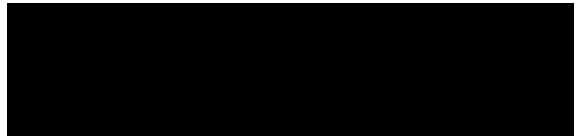

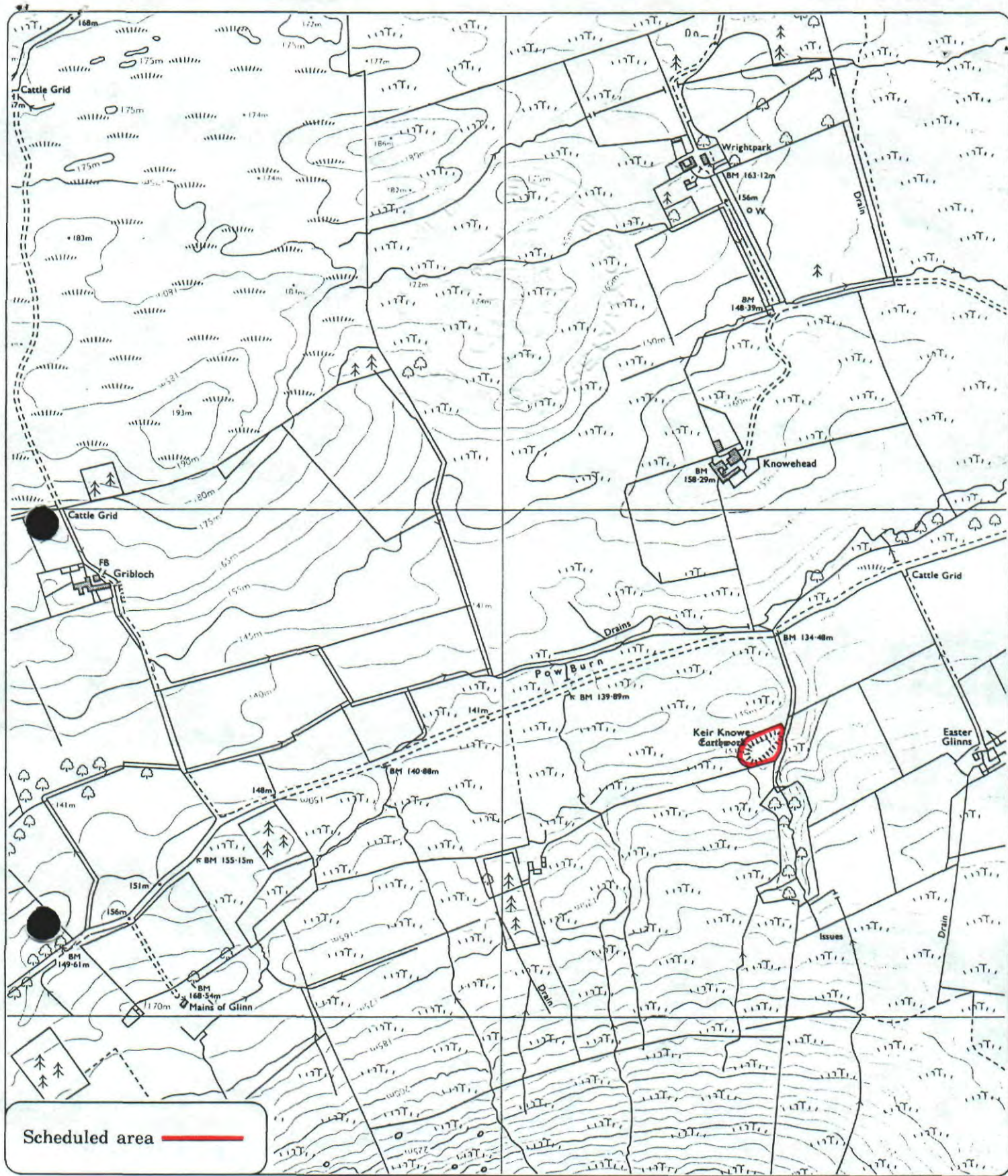

Scheduled area

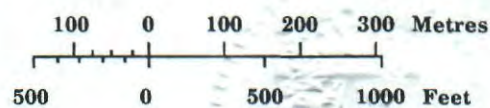
Keir Knowe, motte 460m W of
