IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS
ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

[redacted] the owners of the Monument known as Avondale or Strathaven Castle comprising a motte, castle (in ruins) and outworks all contained within that area or piece of ground extending to four thousand square yards or thereby bounded on the south-east, south, south-west and west by the Powmillan Burn, on the north by the road continuing westwards from Stonehouse Road of Strathaven and on the east-north-east by other subjects lying on the south or south-east side of said Stonehouse Road, being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of Three Roods and Thirtyone and five-tenths poles of ground, part of the lands of Strathaven described in the Feu Disposition in favour of the [redacted] recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines applicable to the County of Lanark of the Sixteenth day of August Nineteen hundred and eleven, situated in the Parish of Avondale and County of Lanark.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

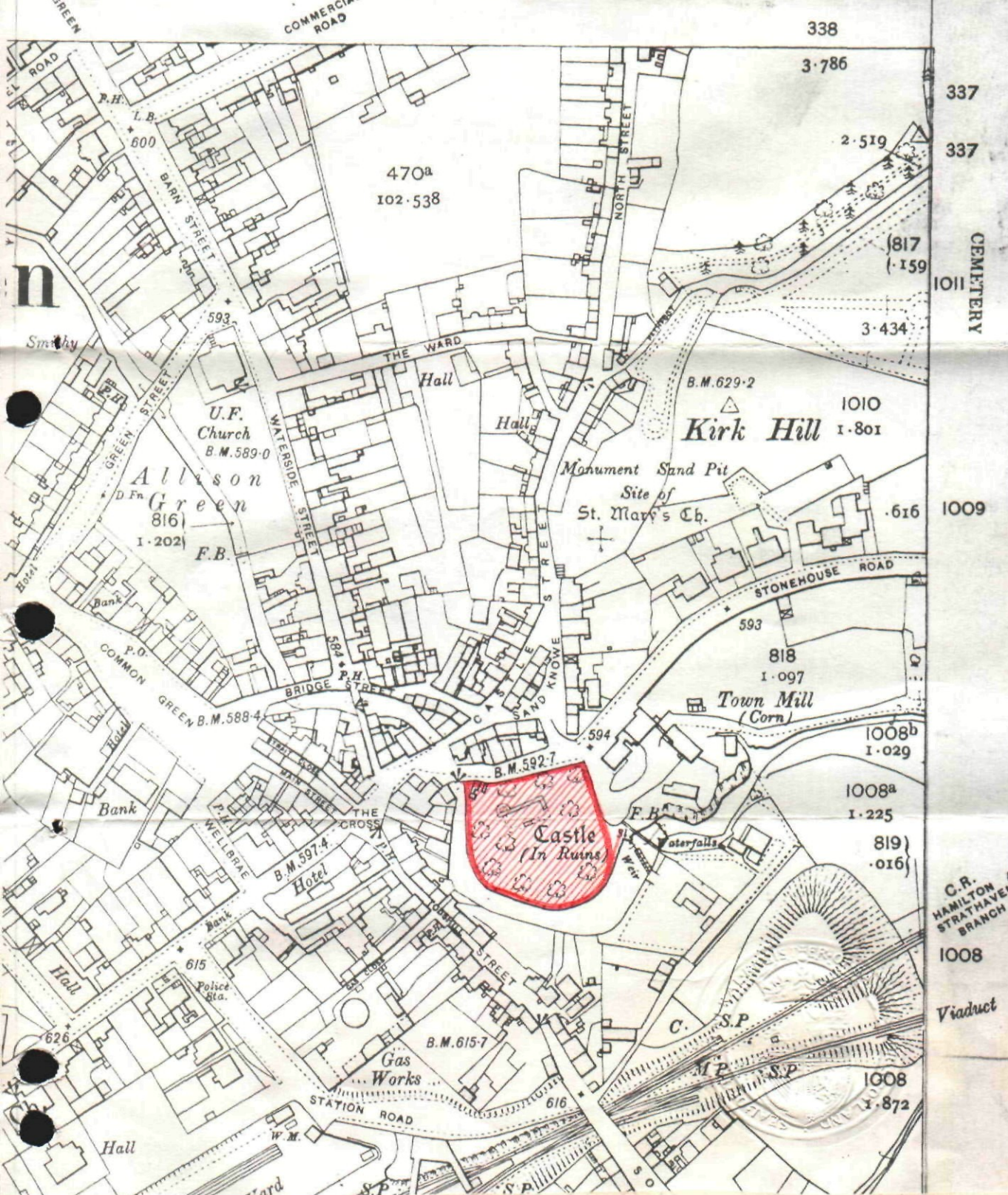
