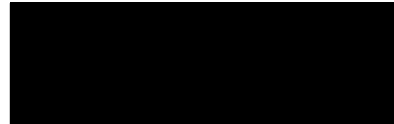

AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Hoddom Bridge, Hoddom Church and monastery 300m E of dated 26 June 1968 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Dumfries on 25 July 1968 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the monument now known as Hoddom Church, church, burial ground and monastery, and the area of the scheduled monument consisting of the foundations of a succession of churches within a burial ground, surrounded by the extensive remains of an early Christian monastery. The latter are only visible from the air, as marks in growing crops. The area to be scheduled consists of two fields and is bounded by modern fences on the W, N and E and by the River Annan to the S, together with an area around the remains in which evidence of their construction and use may survive as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

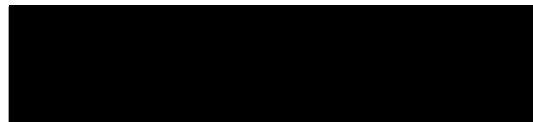

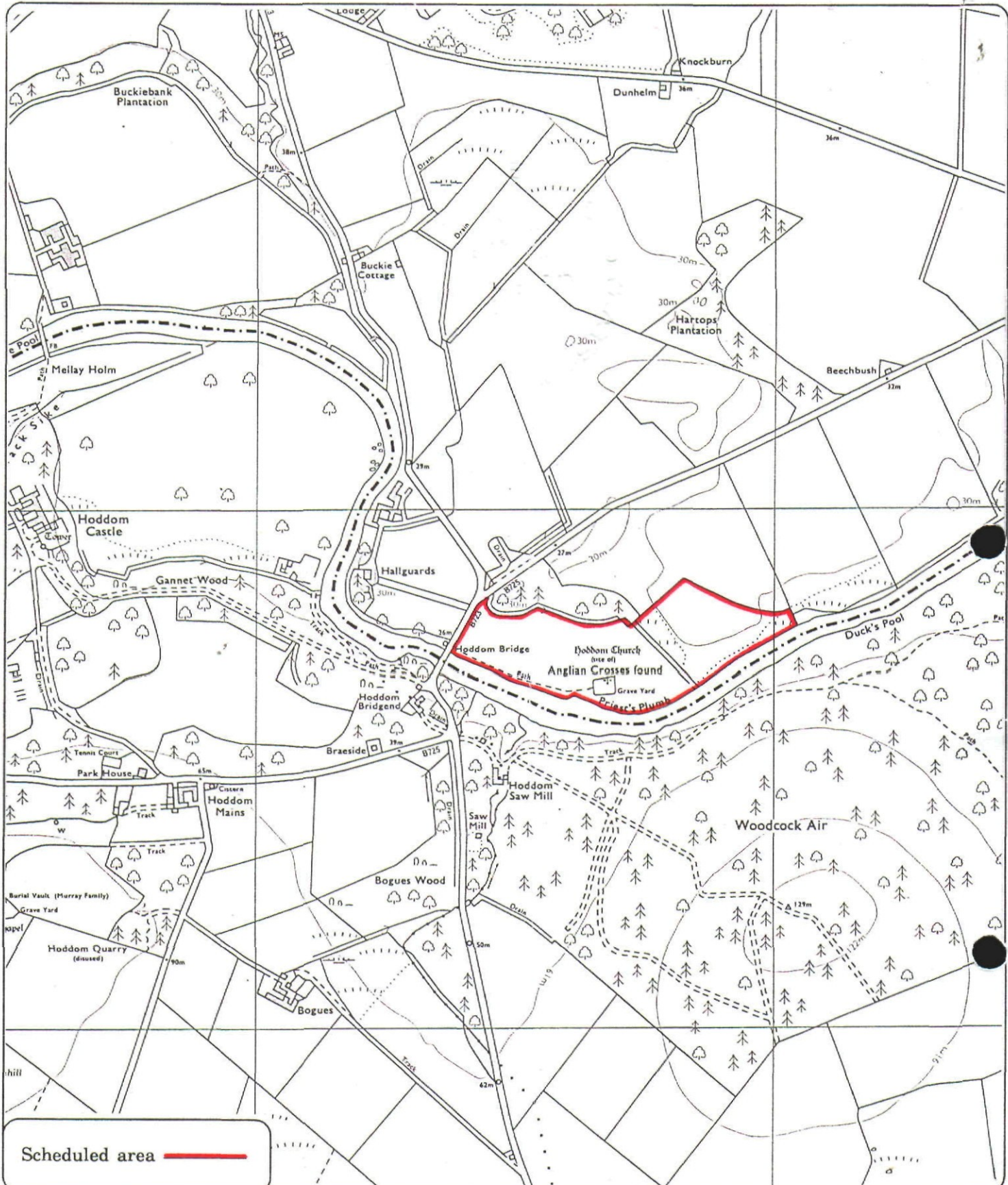

Scheduled area ———

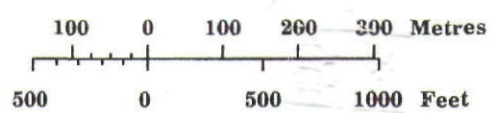
Hoddom Church, church, burial ground and monastery
