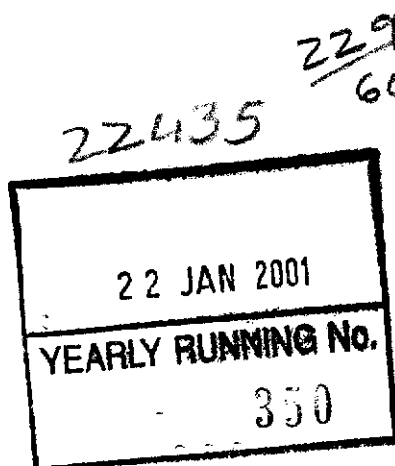

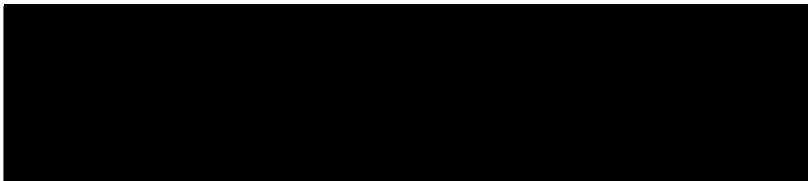

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Panmure Castle and Moat consists of the remains of a quadrangular stone-built castle with rectangular towers at the angles, and the remains of ranges around the perimeter of the enclosed courtyard. It is thought to be of thirteenth century date, but with considerable later modifications. The area to be scheduled is irregular, measuring 140m due N-S and a maximum of 105m E-W. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Panbride and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

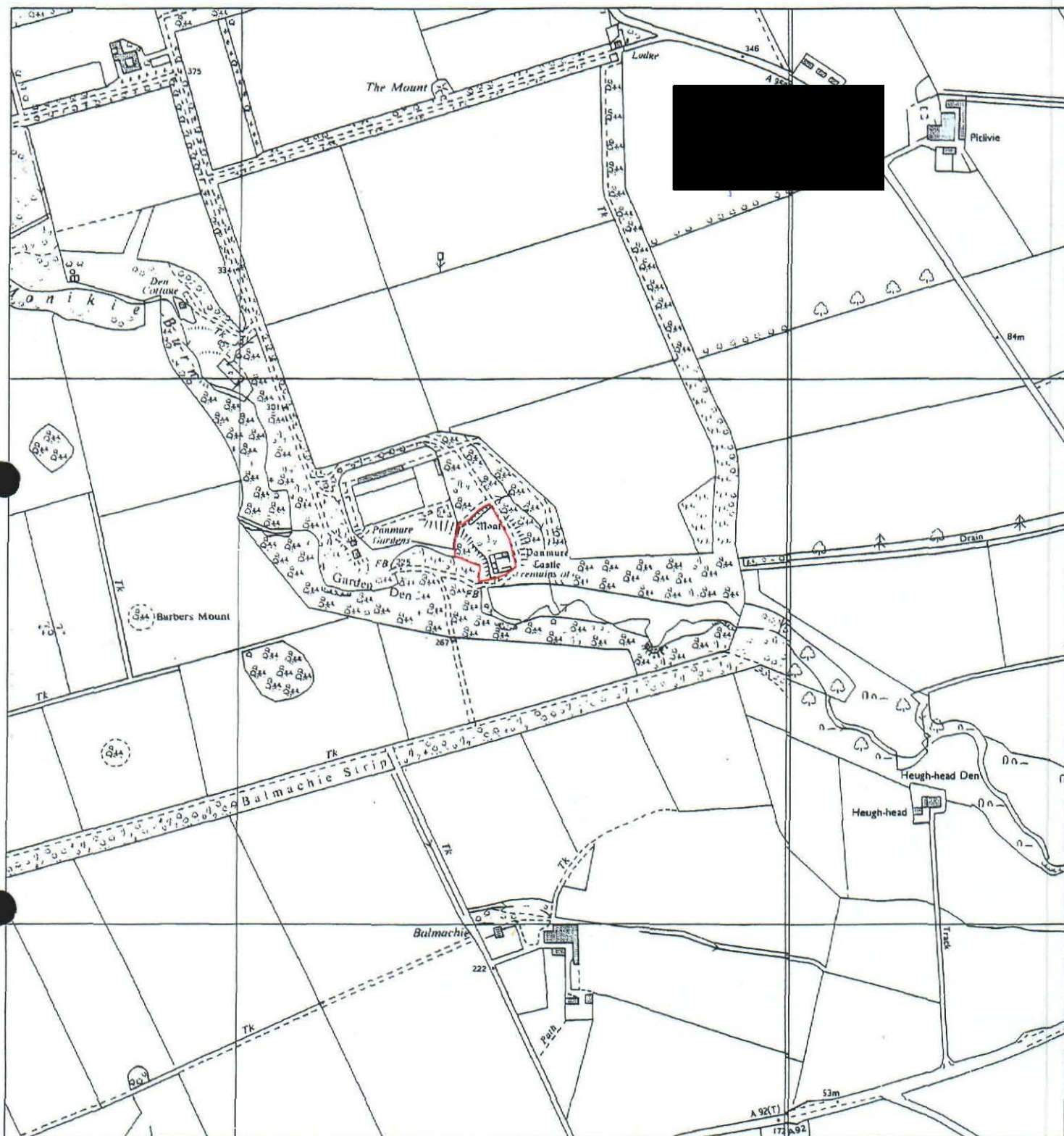
