THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931

To

Owner of the Monument situated on St Fillan's Hill being a Dark Age Fort known as Dundurn Fort which consists of a citadel occupying the topmost part of the hill and measuring about 70ft in internal diameter being bounded by lengths of stone walling which link outcrops of rock, all round which is a complex of enclosures defined by the remains of walls, earthworks and artificial slopes, and making full use of the natural terraces and rock outcrops of the hill among which are visible four probable small hut-circles on the upper reaches of the fort on the north-east and south-east sides and possible cultivation terraces on the west slope of the hill, the whole complex measuring about 1050 feet east to west by 780 feet and all as coloured red on the annexed plan

situated in the Parish of Comrie and
County of Perth

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, as read with the Transfer of Functions (Scottish Royal Parks and Ancient Monuments) Order, 1969, the Secretary of State hereby gives notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.

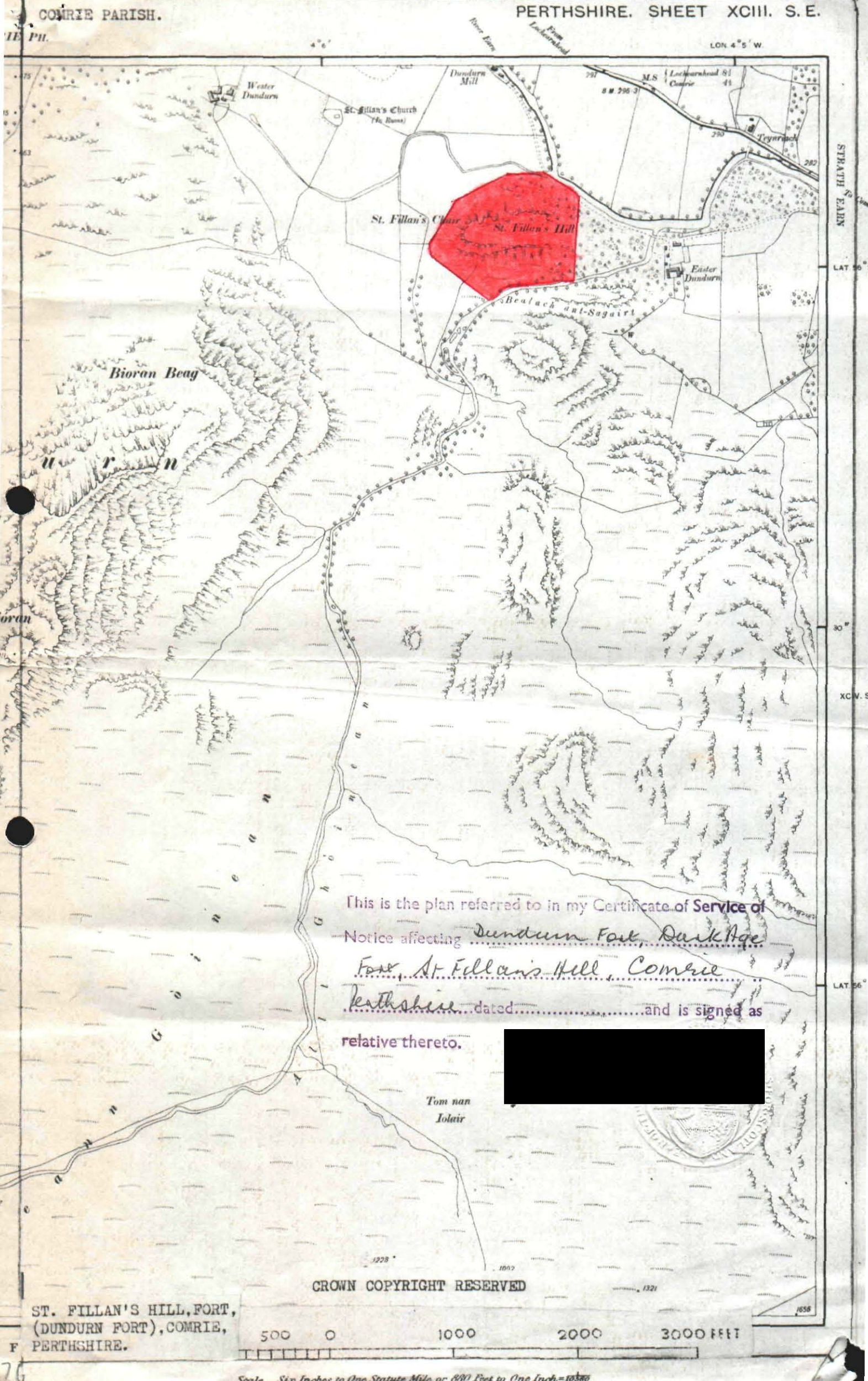

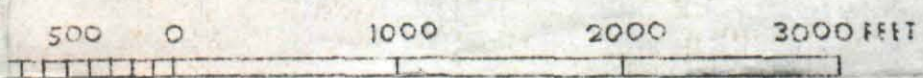
