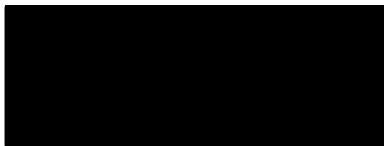

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as Dun Evan, fort, dated 3 December 1969 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Nairn on 24 April 1970 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring 180m SW-NE by 85m NW-SE, to include the fort and outworks, as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

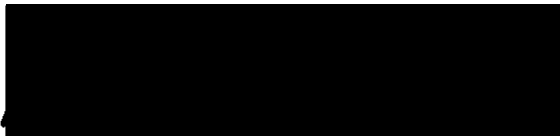

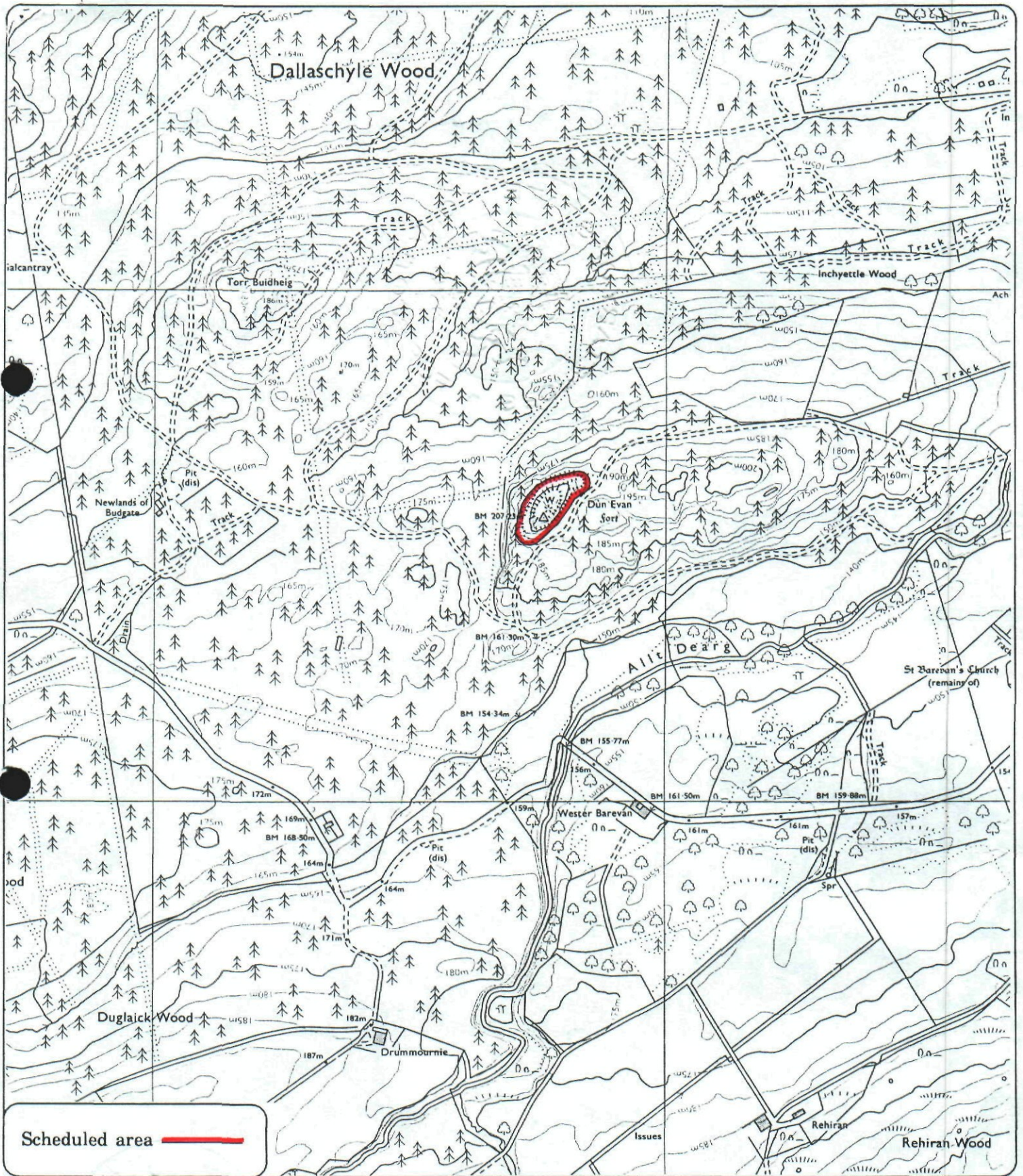

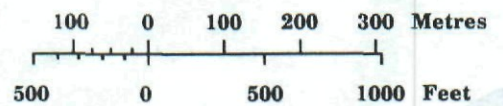
