Owners of the Monument known as Dun an Achaidh, Fort, at Acha, being a dun with a length of 190 feet north east to south west and including a small enclosure at a lower level to the north east with considerable visible remains up to 3 feet high of the external faces of the rampart above the natural rock as shown coloured red on the annexed plan and forming part of the Farm and lands of Acha and Kilbride and others disposed by the Disposition

Limited dated 24th November and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines applicable to the County of Argyll on 3rd December both in the year Nineteen hundred and sixty five.

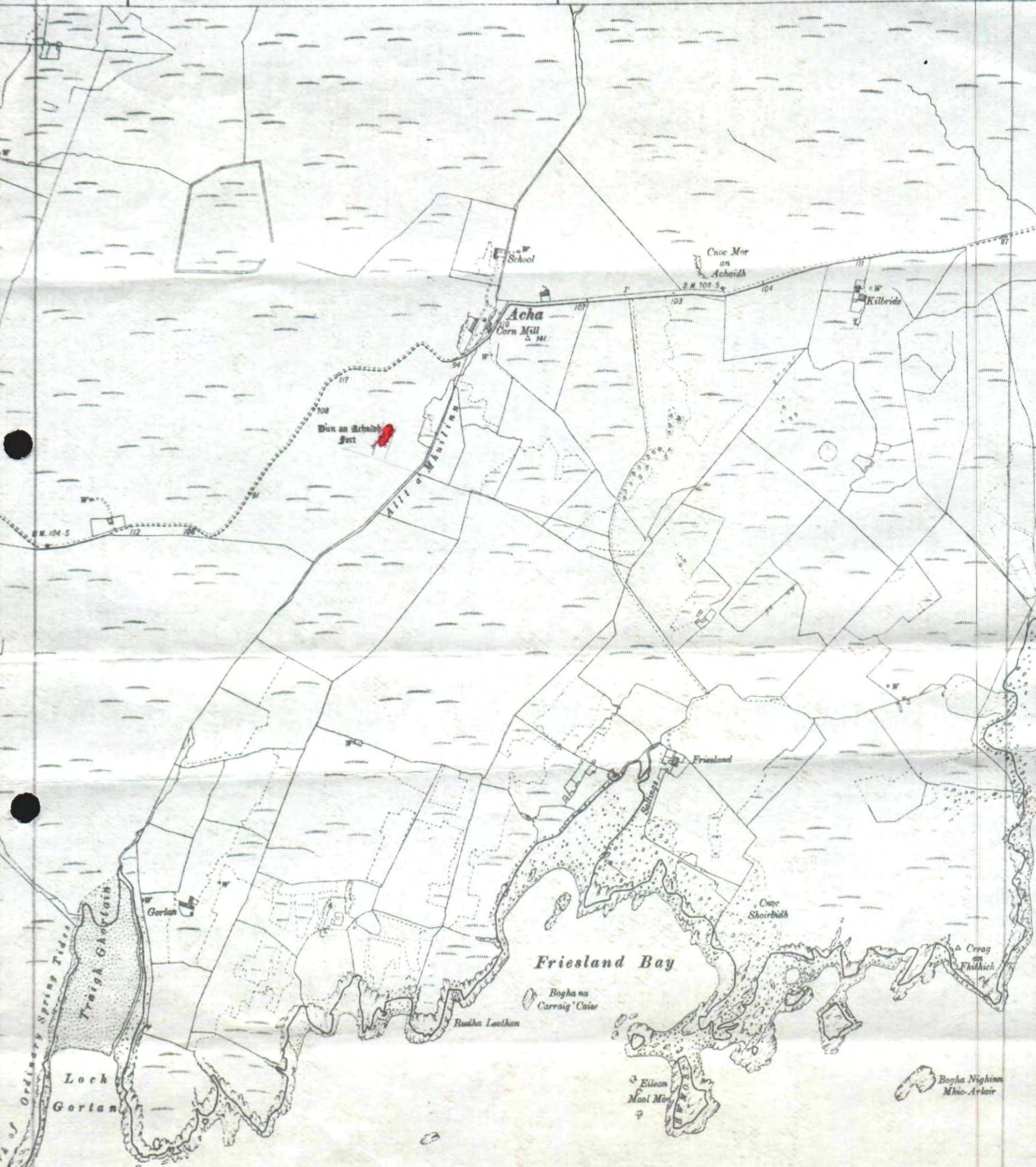

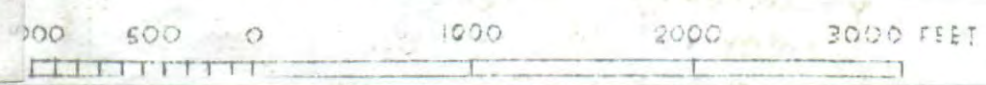
