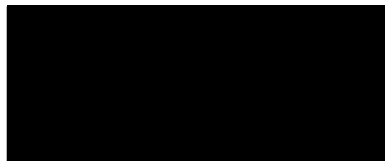

It is irregular in shape with maximum dimensions of 280m E-W by 150m as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

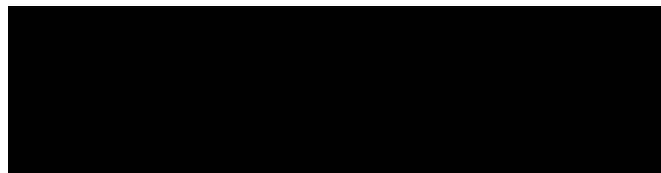

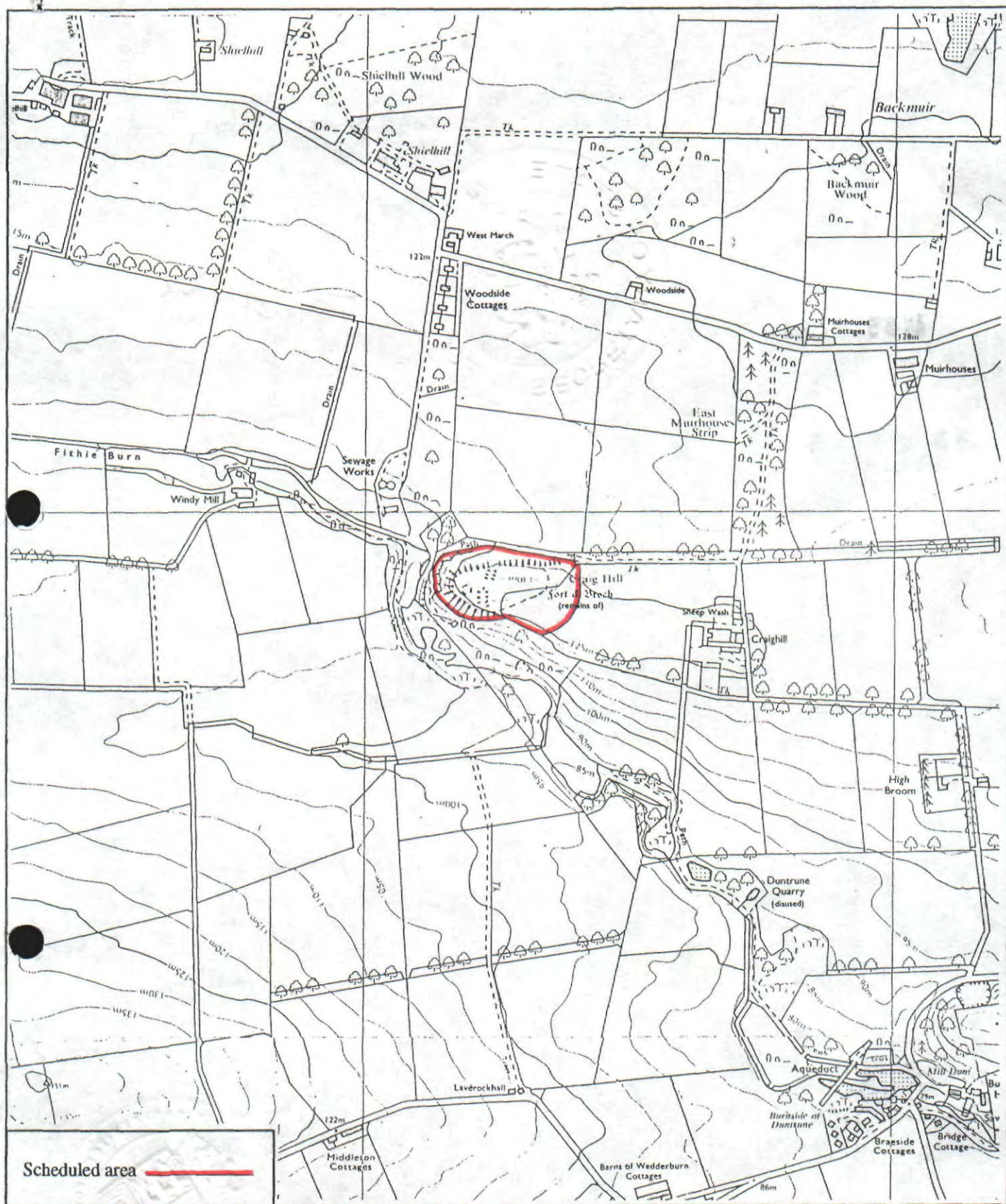

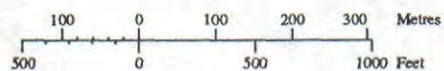
