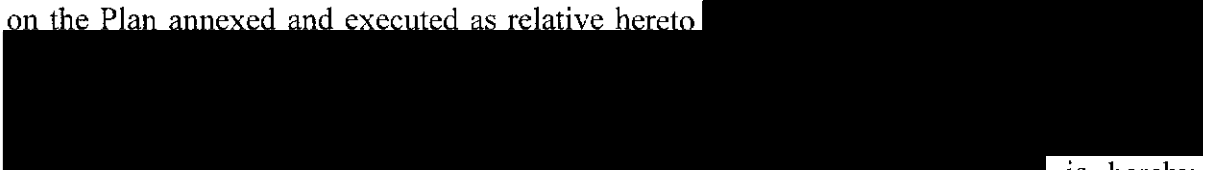

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Green Hill, settlement comprises an enclosed settlement dating from the later prehistoric period. The settlement lies at around 425m OD on the summit of Green Hill where it commands extensive views over the surrounding countryside. The area to be scheduled is a circle 60m in diameter centred on the settlement. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Innerleithen and the County of Peebles as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

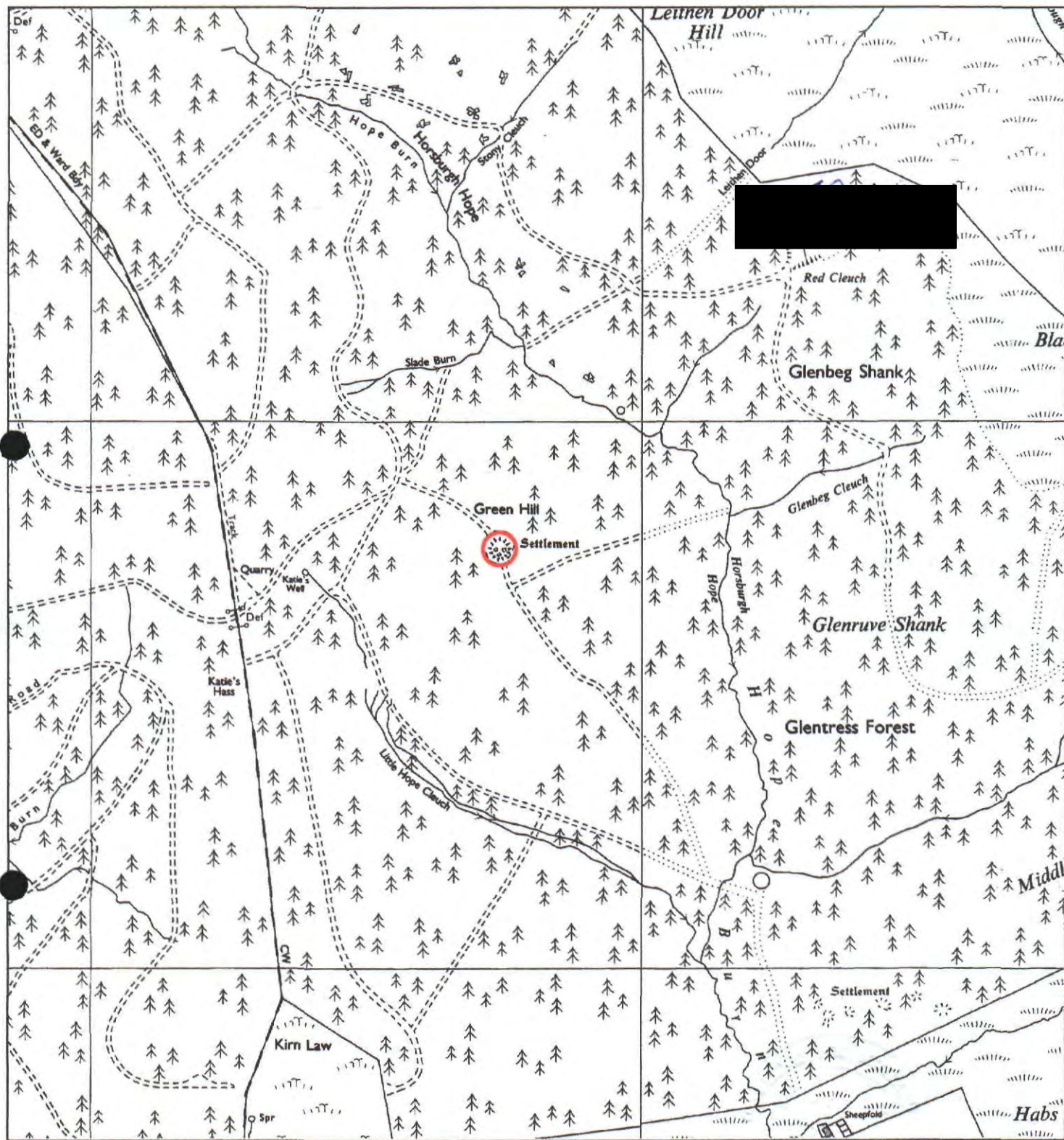
