ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Hardgatehead, Roman road and turnpike road 600m SW of comprises a well preserved stretch of Roman road and later turnpike road situated between Ingraston and Hardgatehead farms. The area to be scheduled is linear on plan and measures 365m by 20m to include the roadway, side ditches and associated evidence, such as quarry pits. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Linton and the County of Peebles as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

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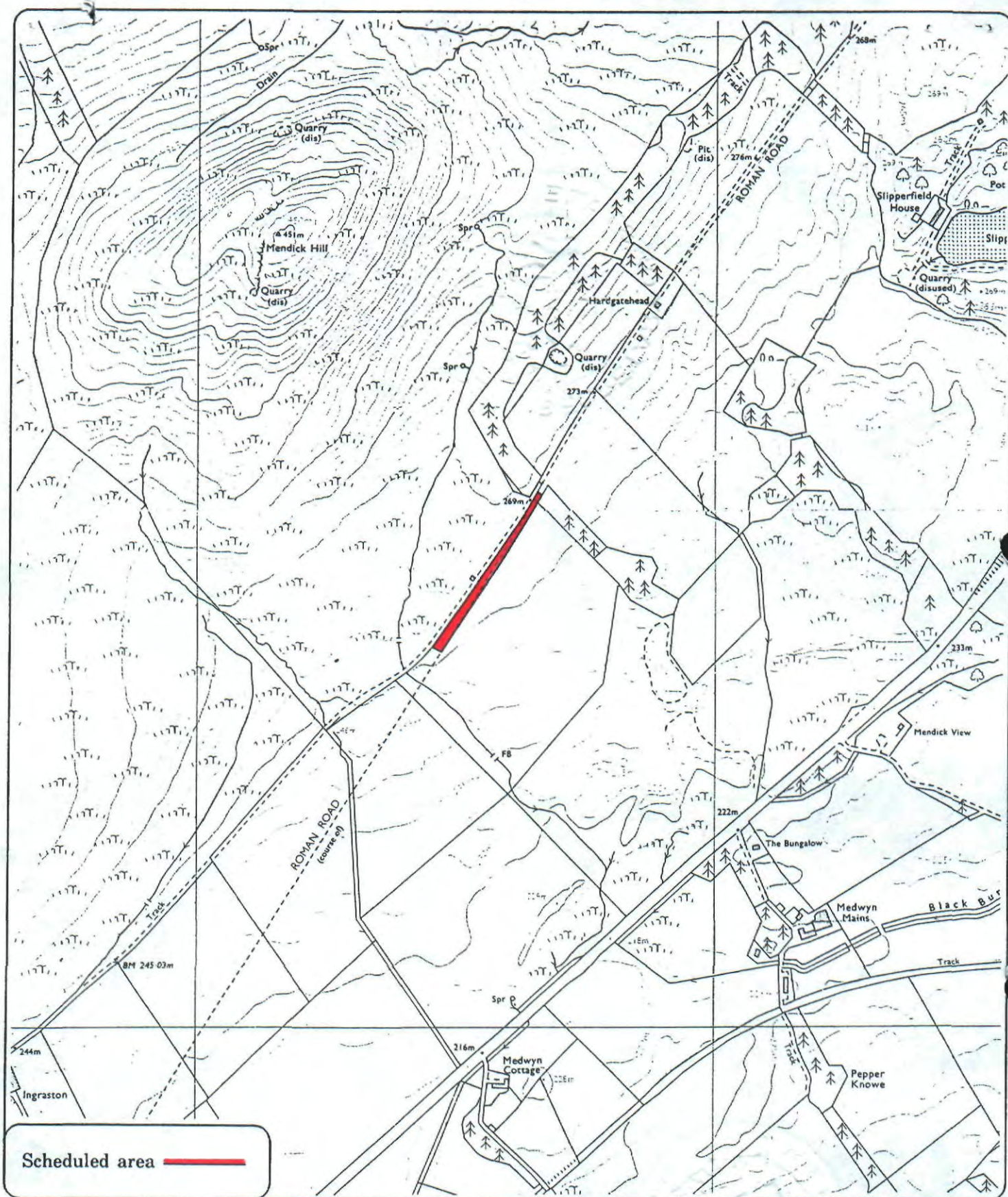

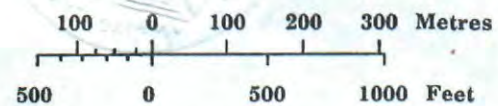
**Hardgatehead, Roman road and
