




THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Wormy Hillock, henge 690m WNW of Finglenny, comprises a henge, situated below the SSE end of a low, but prominent, natural mound on the left bank of the Ealaiche Burn. Such ceremonial earthworks date to the late Neolithic or early Bronze Age (the later third or early second millennium BC). The area to be scheduled is circular, centred on the henge, to include the henge and an area around it within which evidence for its construction and use can be expected to be preserved. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Rhynie and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

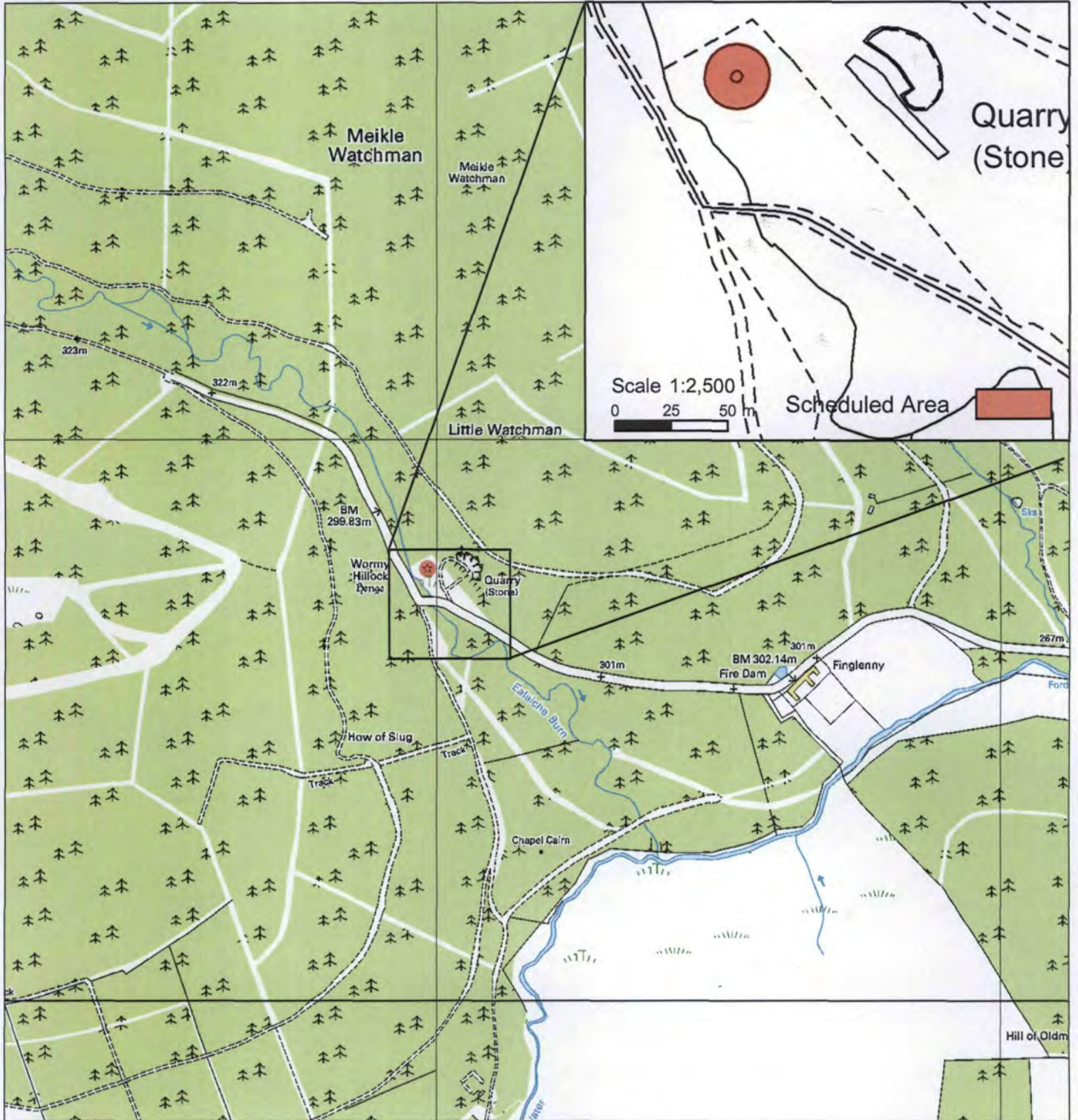

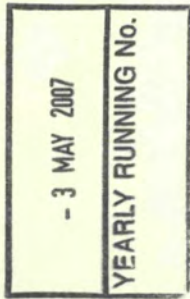
Representation of the
