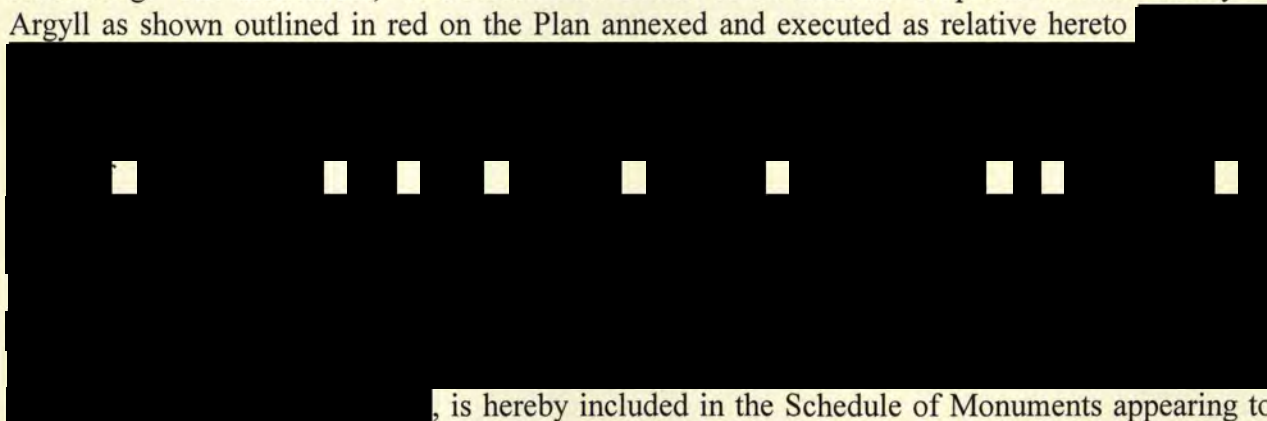


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

3645

The monument known as Saddell Abbey, comprises the fragmentary remains of the Cistercian Saddell Abbey which lie on a slightly raised promontory immediately above the confluence of Saddell Water and Allt nam Manach. The area to be scheduled is irregular with maximum dimensions 192m east-west by 81m north-south. It includes the remains of the abbey and the graveyard and the collection of stones in the stone shelter, along with an area within which archaeology associated with the abbey and the graveyard might be expected to survive. The stone shelter itself; the boundary walls; any burial lairs within the graveyard which are still active; the top 30cm of all paths and tracks; the top 30cm of deposits of the area outside the graveyard boundary, and the footprint of the house named Allt Nam Manach are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Saddell and Skipness and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



, is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

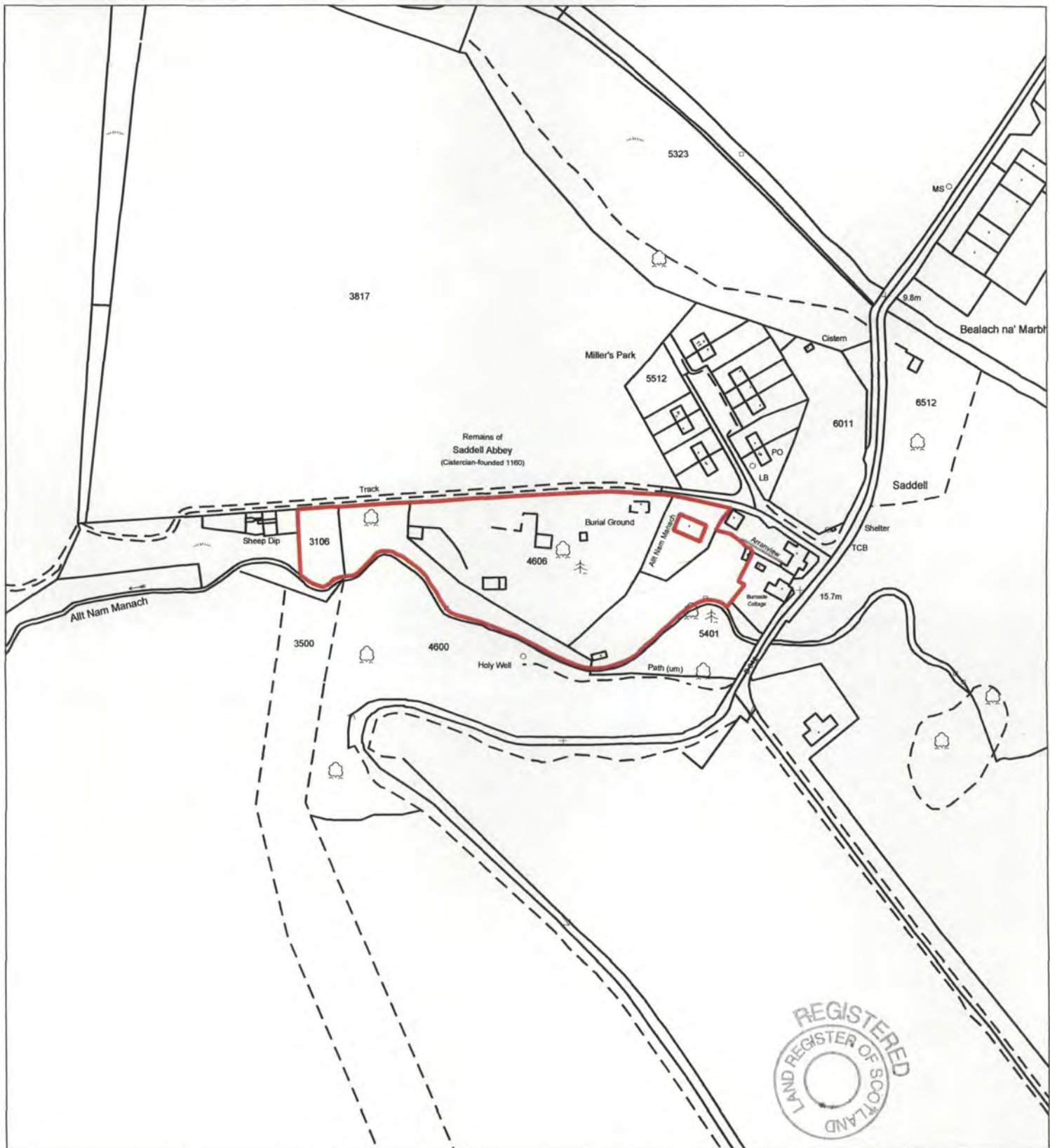

Scheduled Area

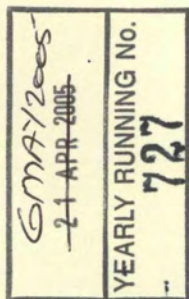
