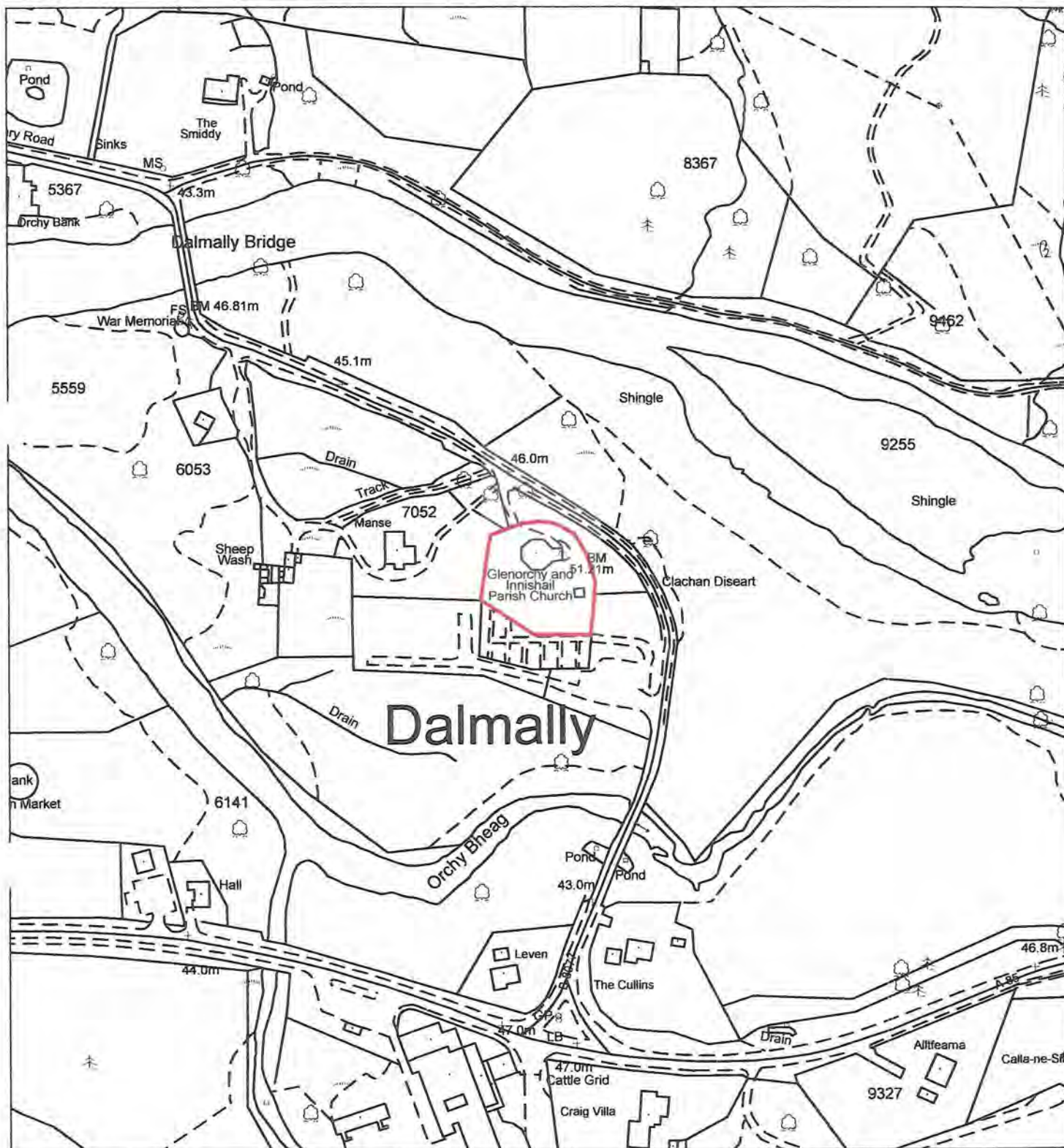
The monument known as Glenorchy Parish Church, churchyard and tombstones, comprises the churchyard of the present parish church of Glenorchy which contains a number of medieval graveslabs and was the site of a medieval and a seventeenth-century church. The area to be scheduled is irregular with maximum dimensions of 50m N-S by 50m E-W to include the churchyard within the boundary walls. The 19th-century church, the burial layers in active use, the boundary walls and the top 30cm of the paths are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glenorchy and Inishail and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
