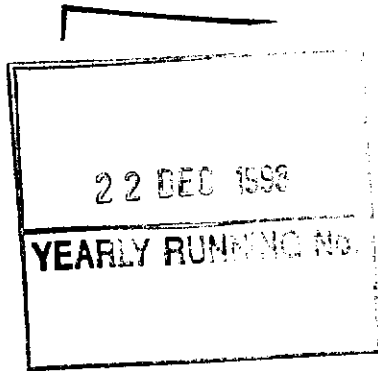

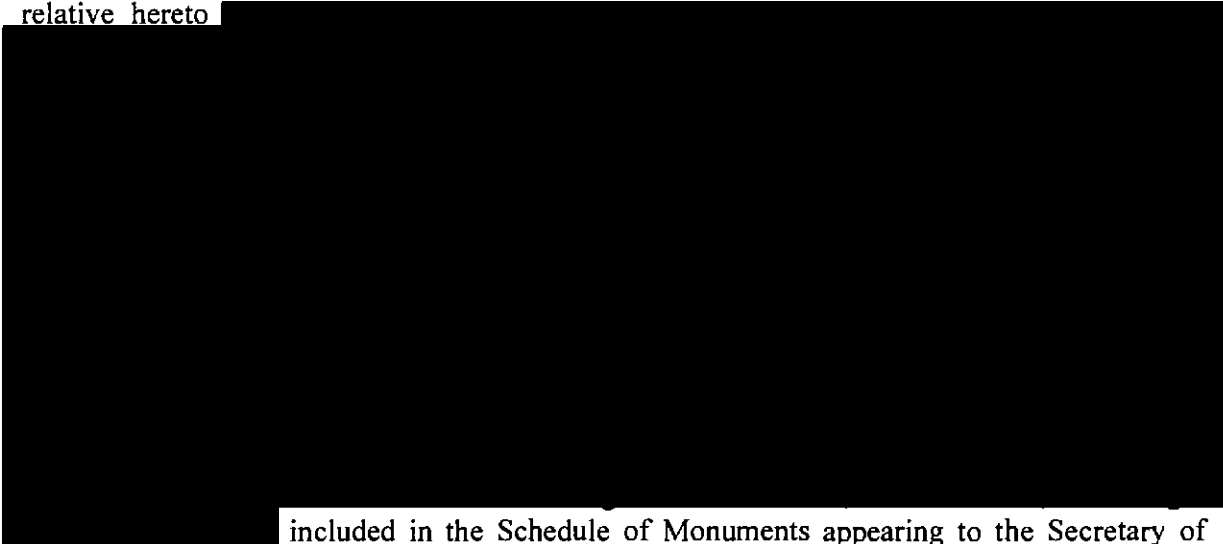

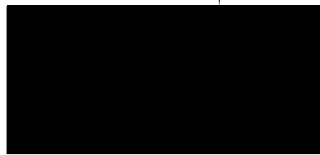
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Old Scatness, broch and settlement SE of Cletts comprises the remains of an extensive and very well-preserved Iron Age settlement, together with traces of earlier settlement and associated agricultural activity. The area to be scheduled is in two parts, N and S of the access road. The N part has maximum measurements of 95m N-S by 80m E-W, and is bounded to the N by the edge of the airport access road (on the line established in 1975) and to the S by the edge of the hostel access road. The S part has maximum measurements of 100m E-W by 75m N-S and is bounded to the N by the edge of the hostel access road and elsewhere largely by existing fences. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dunrossness and the County of Shetland as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section I(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

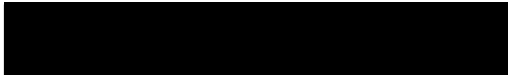

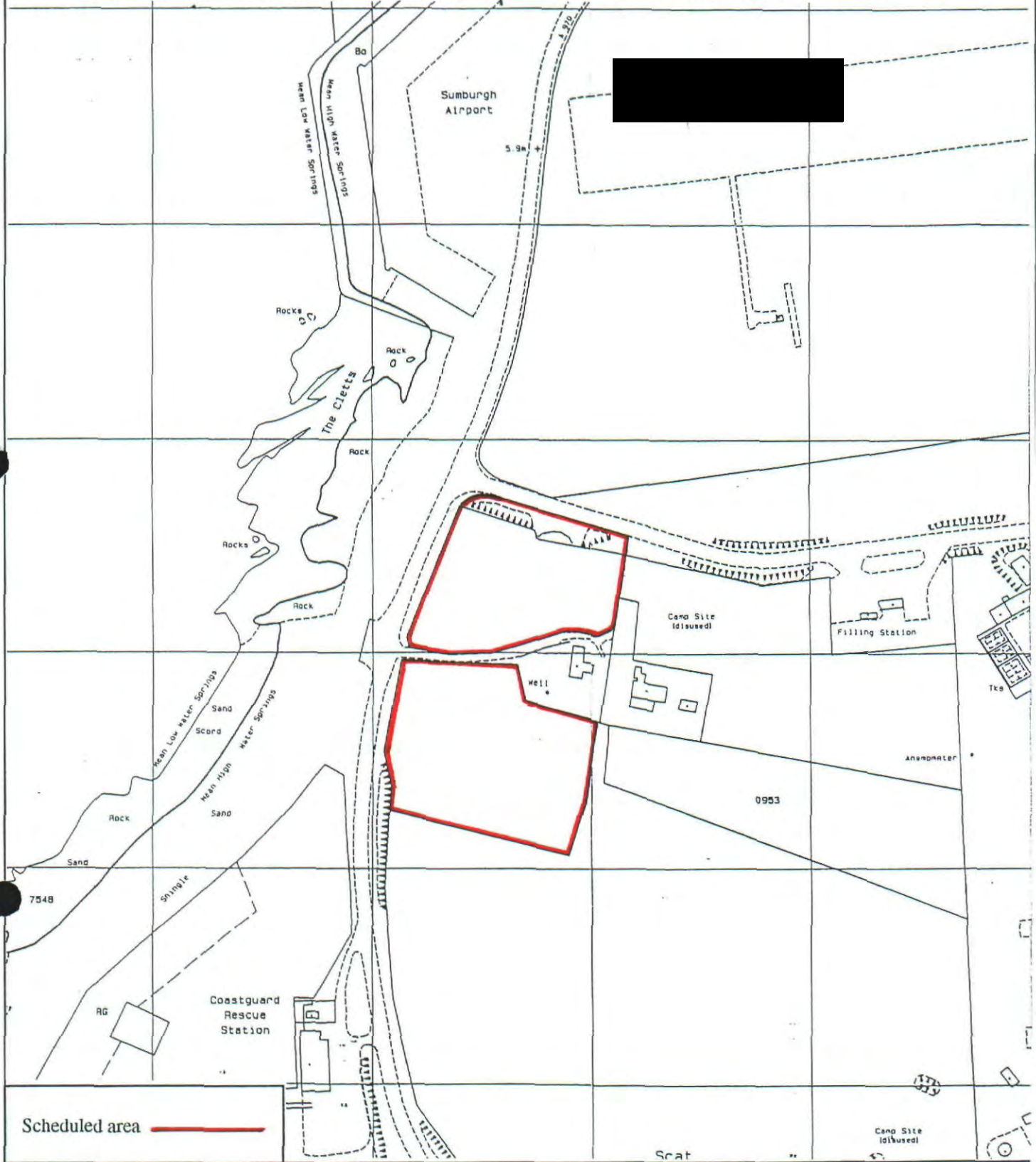

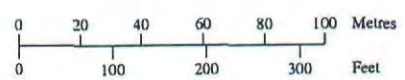
Old Scatness, broch and settlement
