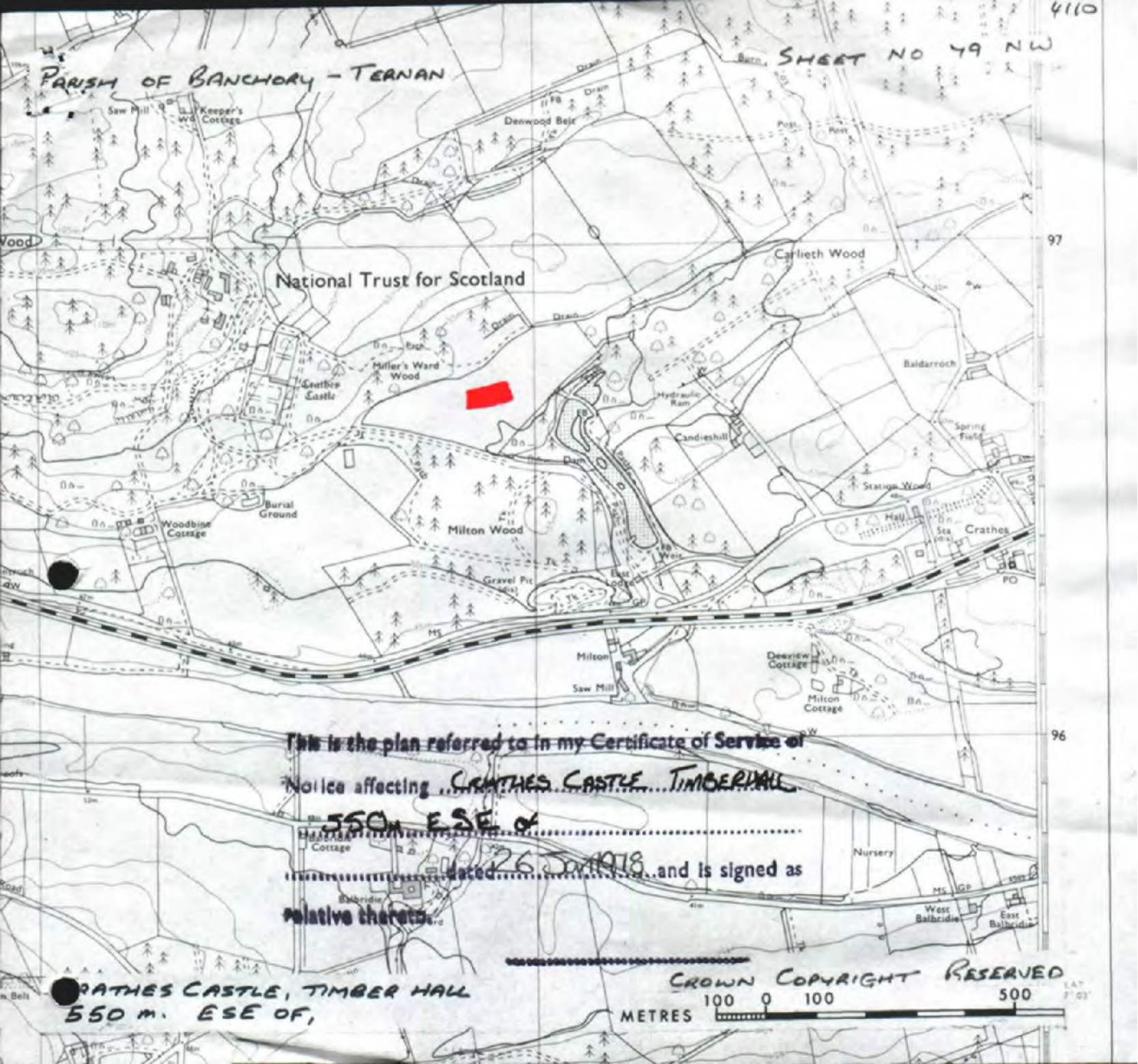

PARISH OF BANCHORY - TERAN



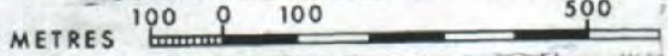
