


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

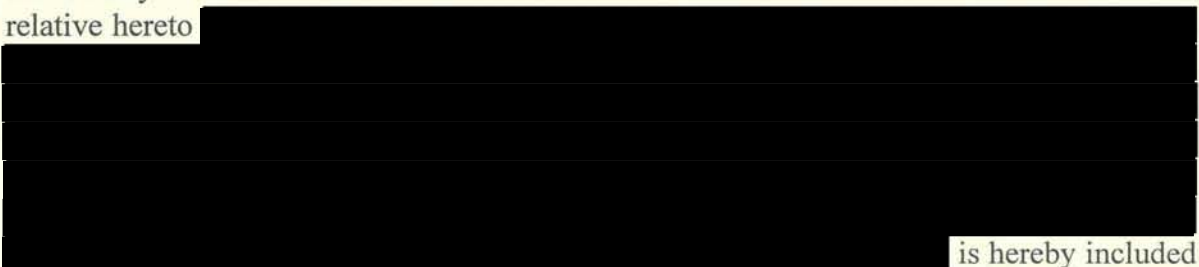

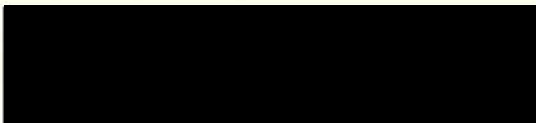

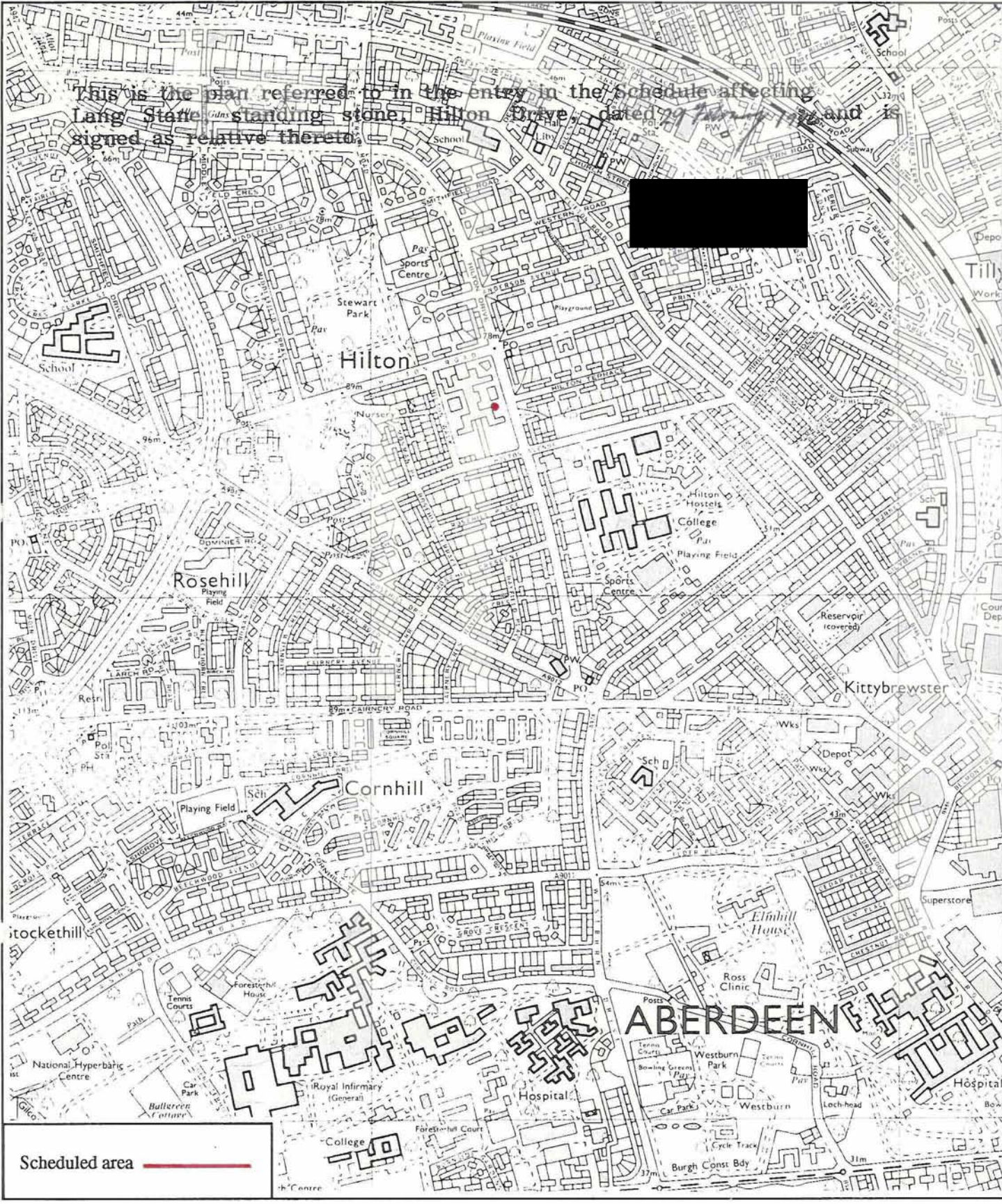
