IN THE MATTER OF THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS ACTS, 1913 AND 1931.

To

the owner of the Monument known as Green Castle Earthwork, contained within an irregular area of ground measuring 450 ft. at its maximum length from north-north-east to south-south-west and 350 ft. at its maximum width from east-south-east to west-north-west and bounded on the north-north-east and east-south-east by the wall or fence forming the east boundary of a belt of trees on the east or left bank of the Devilly Burn, the south-south-west point of said area being situated 25 yards northeast of the Mill Lade serving Mill of Kincardine at its nearest point; 110 yards east-south-east of the east end of the Weir on said Burn forming said Mill Lade and 730 yards northwest by north of the northmost corner of the main block of farm buildings at Mill of Kincardine

being the subjects indicated in red colour on the annexed plan and being part of the property known as the lands and Estate of Fasque

situated in the Parish of Fordoun and County of Kincardine.

In accordance with the provisions of Section 6 of the Ancient Monuments Act, 1931, the Minister of Works hereby gives you notice that it is his intention to include the Monument above specified in a list of monuments to be published by him under Section 12 of the Ancient Monuments Consolidation and Amendment Act, 1913.
