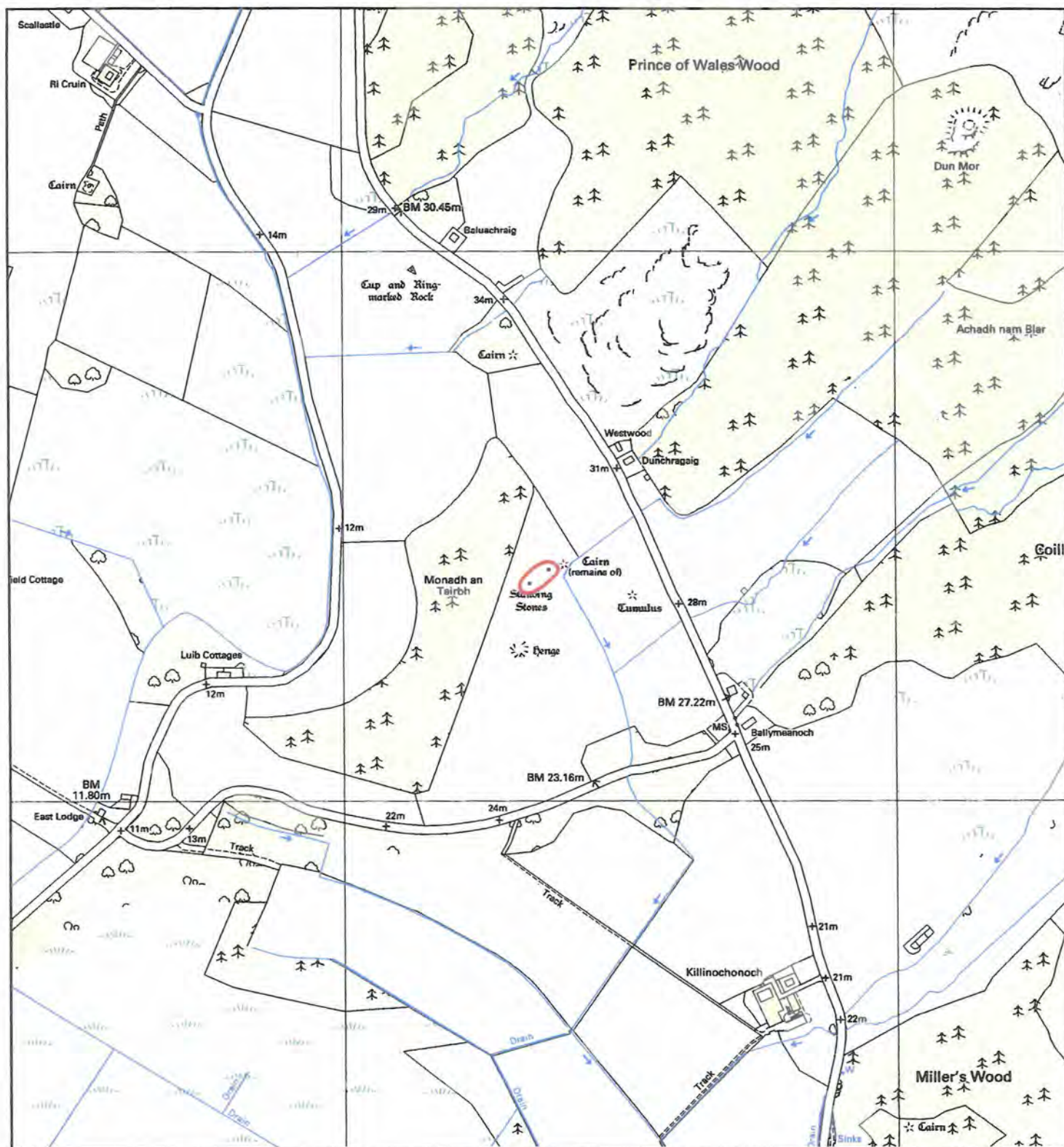
The monument known as Ballymeanoch, standing stones 450m NW of, comprises a group of standing stones situated on a gravel terrace on the W side of Kilmartin Glen, 450m to the NW of Ballymeanoch. The area to be scheduled is an oval 70m NE-SW by 40m NW-SE covering the standing stones and an area around them in which remains associated with their construction and use are likely to survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmichael Glassary and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto 

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
