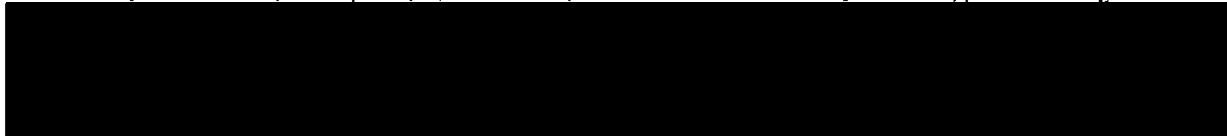


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument comprising a standing stone and recumbent stones and socket holes filled with earth, peat and stone, forming the circumference of a stone circle of 41m diameter and all within a circle of diameter 60m centred on the centre of the stone circle known as Achmore Stone Circle in the Parishes of Lochs and Uig and County of Ross and Cromarty delineated in black and coloured red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto, which monument forms part of the lands known as Soval being the subjects



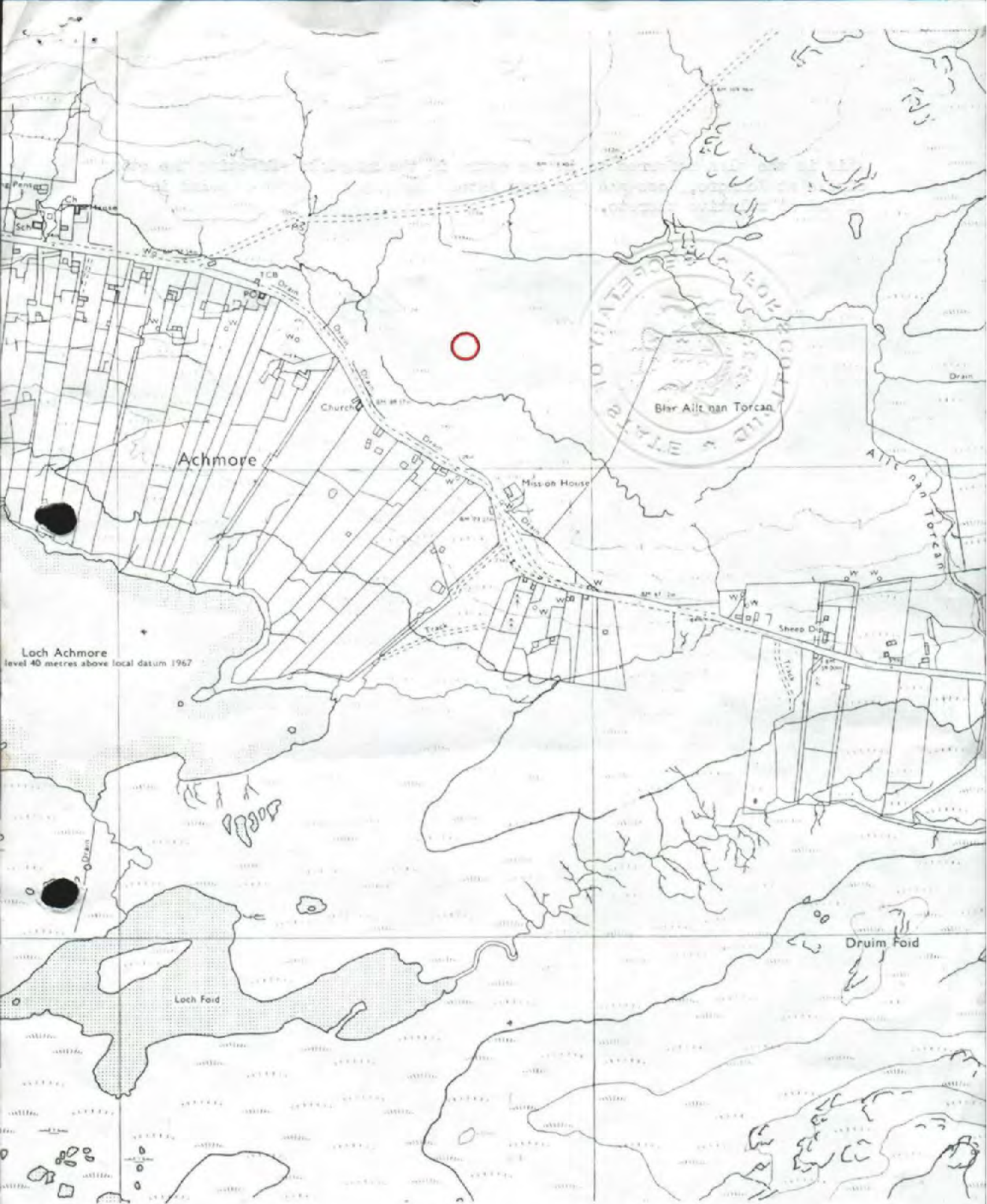
