

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cnoc Fada standing stones, Dervaig, Mull, comprises Cnoc Fada standing stones (sometimes known as the Kilmore or Dervaig B standing stones), which are prehistoric in date. The monument consists of an alignment of five monoliths aligned NNW/SSE. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related evidence is likely to survive. It is rectangular and measures 34m NNW-SSE by 23m WSW-ENE. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilninian and Kilmore and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

[REDACTED], is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

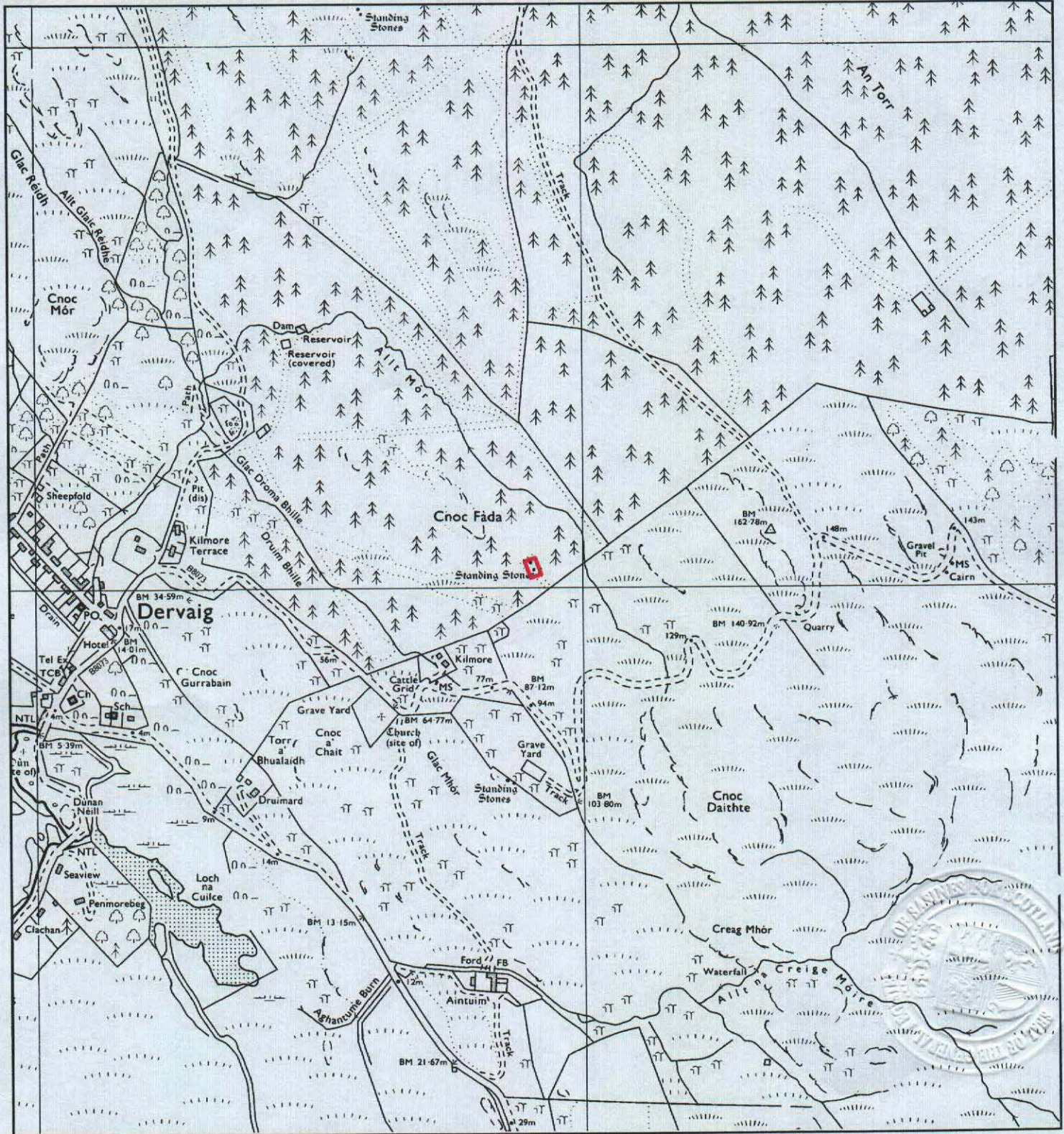

Scheduled Area

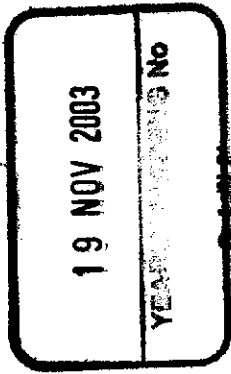
