The monument known as Mansworn Rig, house, fields and cairns 450m E of Tullo Hill comprises a round house, field banks and cairns and all in area measuring 150m square with its northeast corner 90m SW of Beattie's cairn and with its northern boundary formed by the parish boundary but excluding at its SE corner the modern field boundary and all to the SE of it. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Menmuir and the County of Angus as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

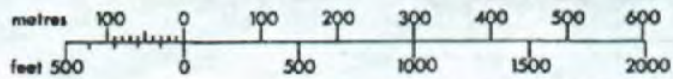
