



The monument known as Dirrington Great Law, three cairns comprises three burial cairns of the Bronze Age and an area around them in which traces of contemporary activity will survive, situated on the summit of Dirrington Great Law, the area to be scheduled being rectangular measuring 90m WSW-ESE by 50m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Longformacus and the County of Berwick as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

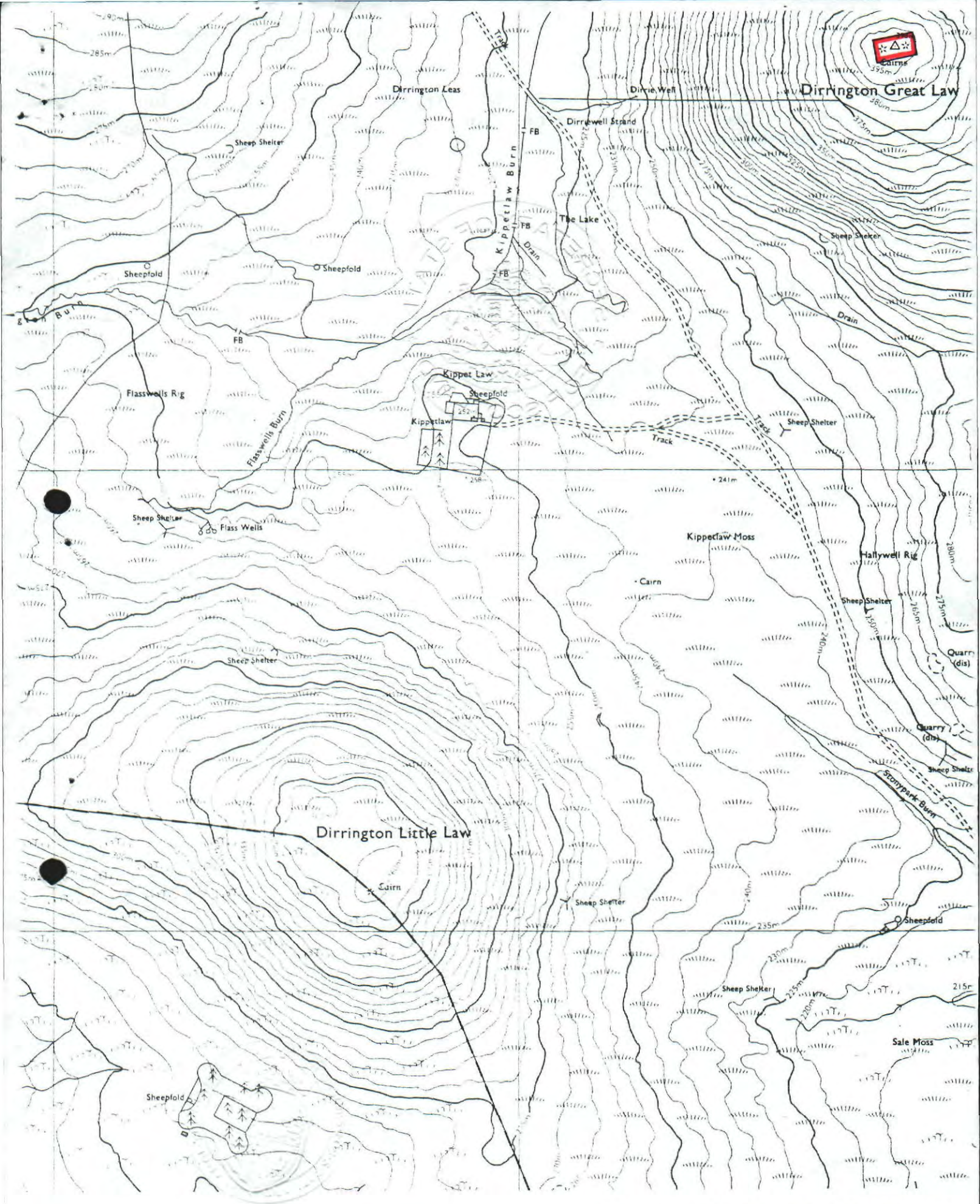
