



THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Old Kinord, settlements and field systems E of comprises the remains of two complex settlements and field systems of the Iron Age, some 2000 to 2500 years old. The eastern complex comprises three well-defined circular house stances (17m-19m in diameter), two enclosures, a souterrain, and a field system of clearance heaps and field walls. The western complex, partly excavated in 1903, comprises six circular house stances (c15m-18m in diameter), two souterrains and a field system of clearance heaps and field walls. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 965m WNW-ESE by 320m transversely to include the settlements and field systems and an area around and between the visible remains, where traces of activity associated with the use of the settlements and field systems will survive. Modern field boundaries and tracks are specifically excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Glenmuick, Tullich and Glengairn and the County of Aberdeen as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects


 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

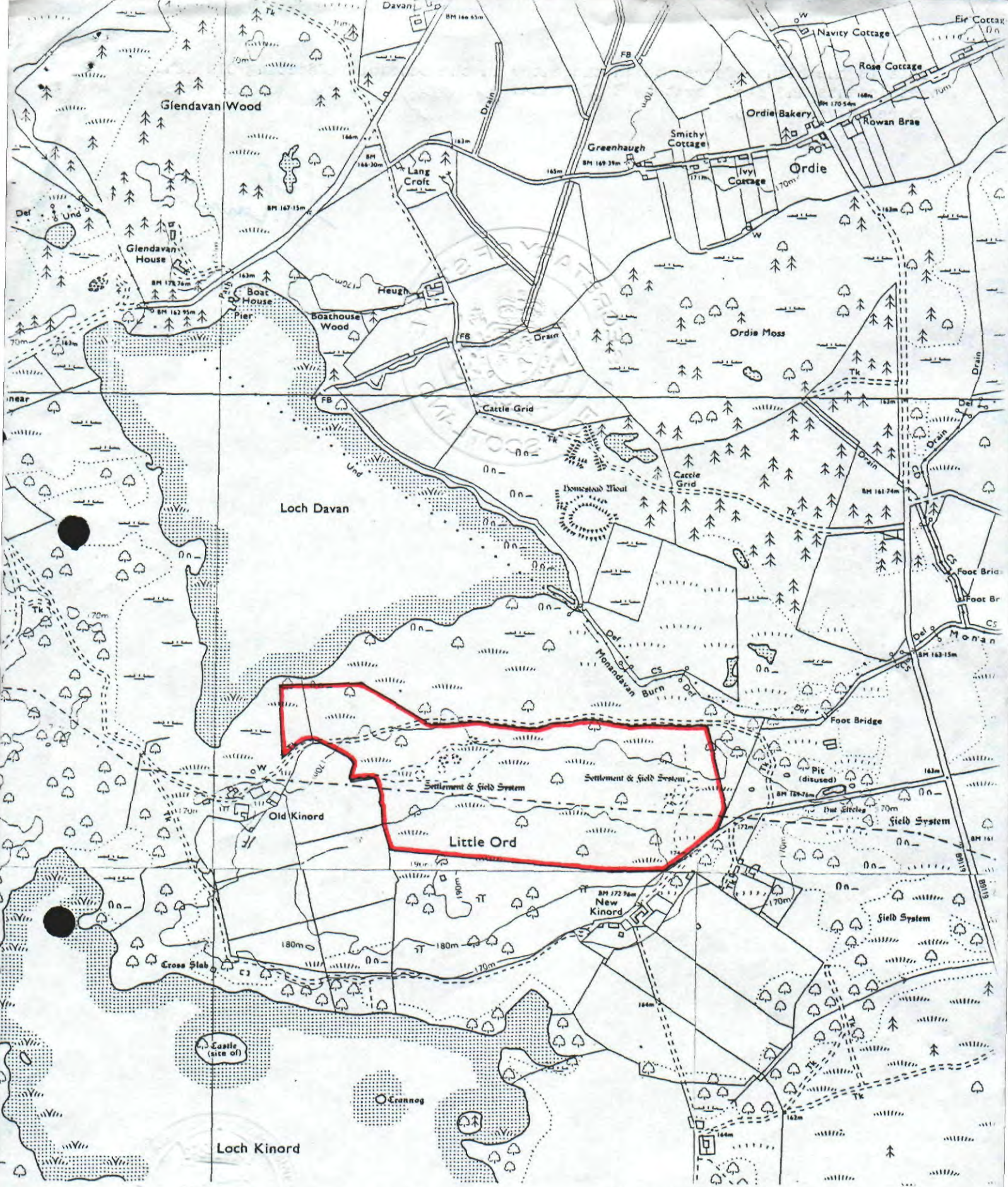

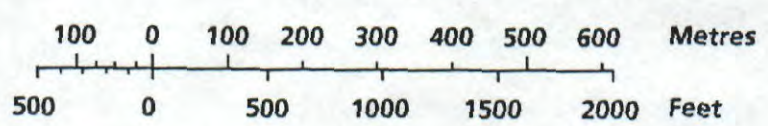


Old Kinord, settlements
