ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Ormond Castle occupies the summit of Ormond Hill and traces of walls forming three courts are visible at different levels on the hill. Within the courts are five rectangular building foundations and along the curtain wall are six turret foundations. The fortified area measures 125m NE-SW by 54m transversely and the area to be scheduled includes the structures described above and an area in which traces of activities associated with their construction and use will survive. It is bounded on the SE by a track and the pear shaped area proposed for scheduling measures up to 200m NE/SW by up to 90m transversely. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Avoch and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects described in the

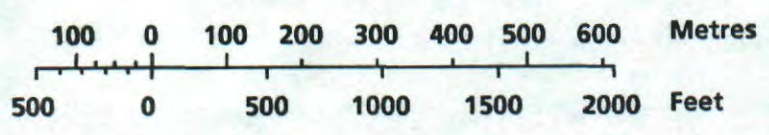
