

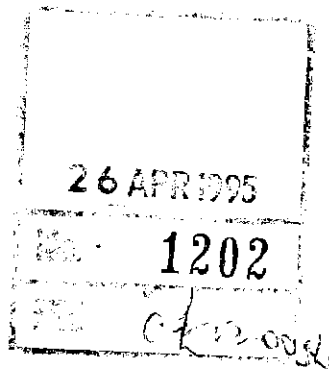

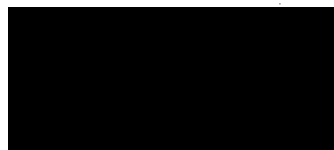

THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
AMENDED ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under Section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument formerly known as Glengeith, earthwork 600m WSW of, dated 15 November 1990 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Lanark on 12 March 1991 now to be known as Glengeith, settlement, bastle house and field system is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to describe the area of the scheduled monument as measuring a maximum of 630m NE-SW by 450m NW-SE, to include the homestead, bastle house and agricultural field remains as shown delineated in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto. The modern roof and supporting structure of the lambing shelter are specifically excluded.

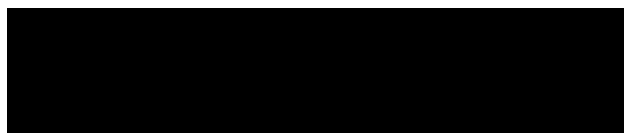

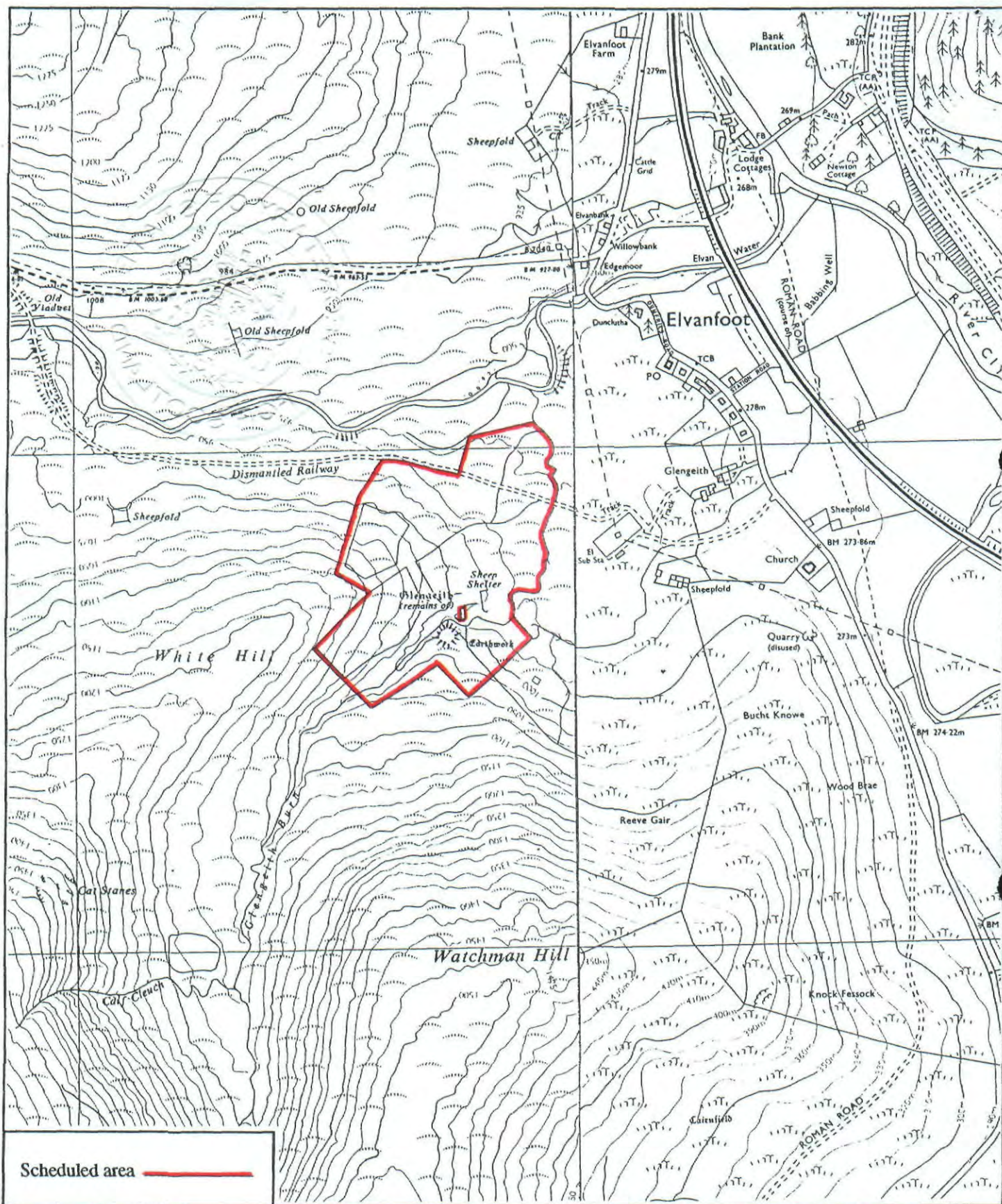

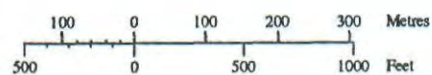
