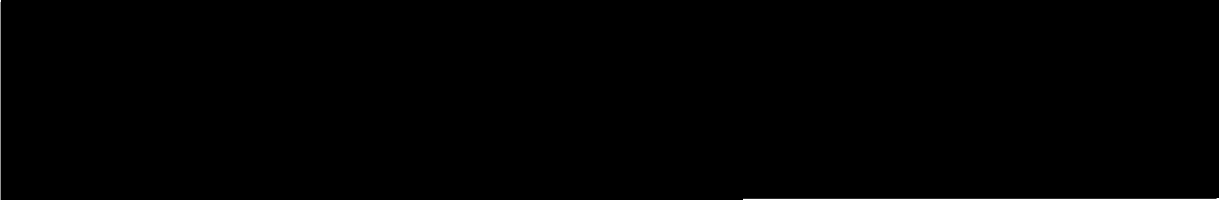

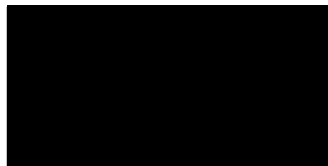
The monument known as Midtown, farmsteads and field systems 800m SE of comprises the remains of a prehistoric farmstead and associated field system overlain by a farmstead and field system of the period before the agricultural improvements. The prehistoric farmstead comprises the remains of three circular houses and a fourth circular enclosure, surviving as turf covered walls; the houses measure between 2.9m and 7.5m across, the enclosure measures 6m in diameter. The field system associated with these structures is marked by low stony walls and numerous field clearance cairns. The pre-improvement farmstead comprises the remains of two single compartment buildings set at right angles to each other; they measure 7.1m by 2.3m and 6.5m by 2.6m respectively. A third building, measuring 11.2m by 3m lies immediately to the NW. The remains of a kiln lie 30m to the SSW. The field system probably associated with the farmstead survives as lengths of tumbled dry stone wall. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 320m WNW to ESE, by a maximum of 200m NE to SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strachan and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

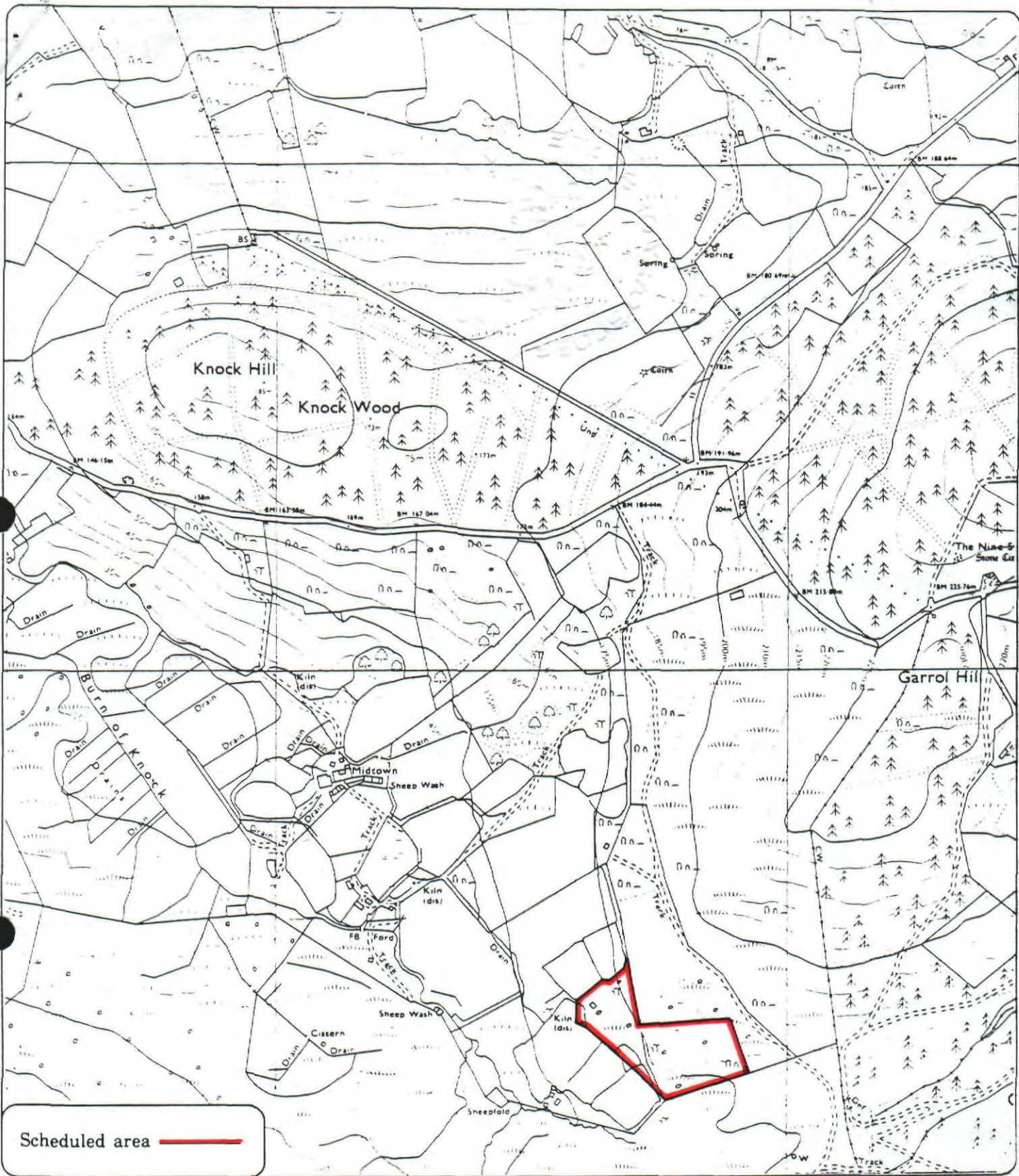

Scheduled area

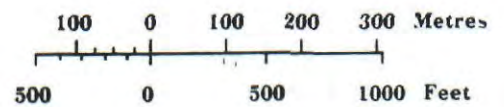
Midtown,
