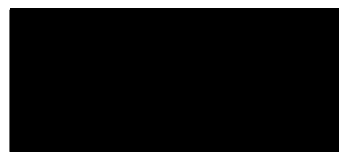

The monument known as Cheynehill Wood, enclosures and field systems 750m N of Hillhead comprises two small circular enclosures, banks and small clearance cairns and about 55 small cairns, in an area trapezoidal in shape with parallel E and W sides 250m apart, its W side measuring 300m NS and its E side 135m and its N side running EW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fetteresso and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

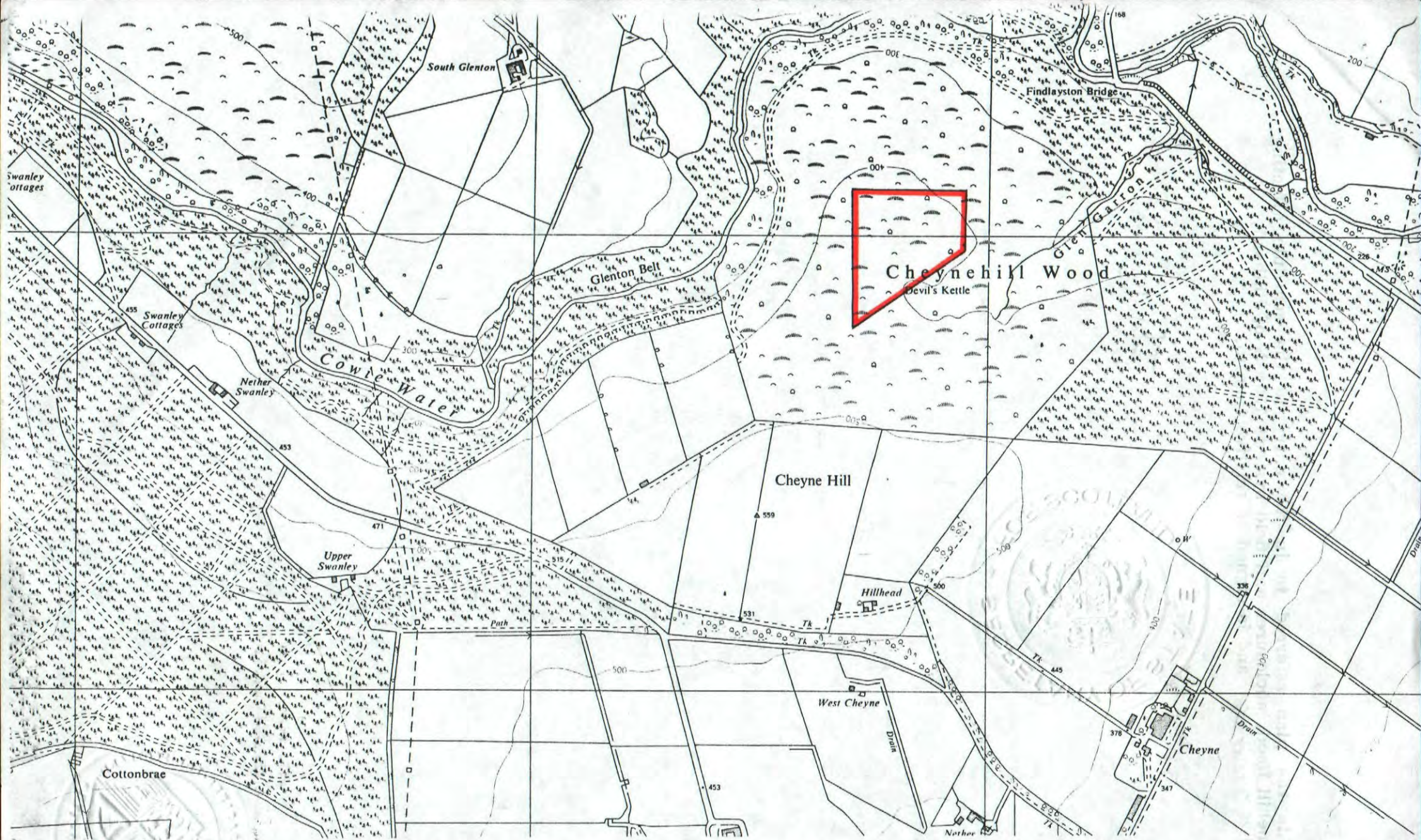

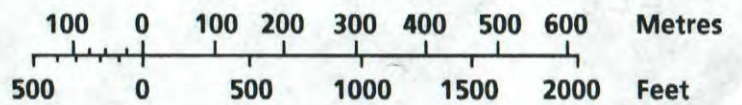
