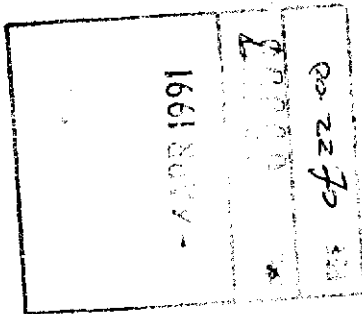

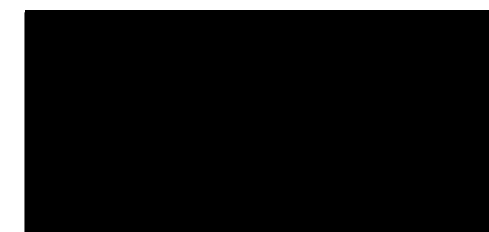
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cairn MacNeillie comprises a burial cairn of the neolithic or Bronze Age situated to the NNW of Cruise. It measures 23.7m NNW-SSE by 21.5m and 1.6m high, although some of this is the result of field clearance dumping. The area to be scheduled includes the cairn and an area around it within which traces of activity associated with its use may be found. It measures 30m in diameter, centred on the monument. The monument, which lies in the Parish of New Luce and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects

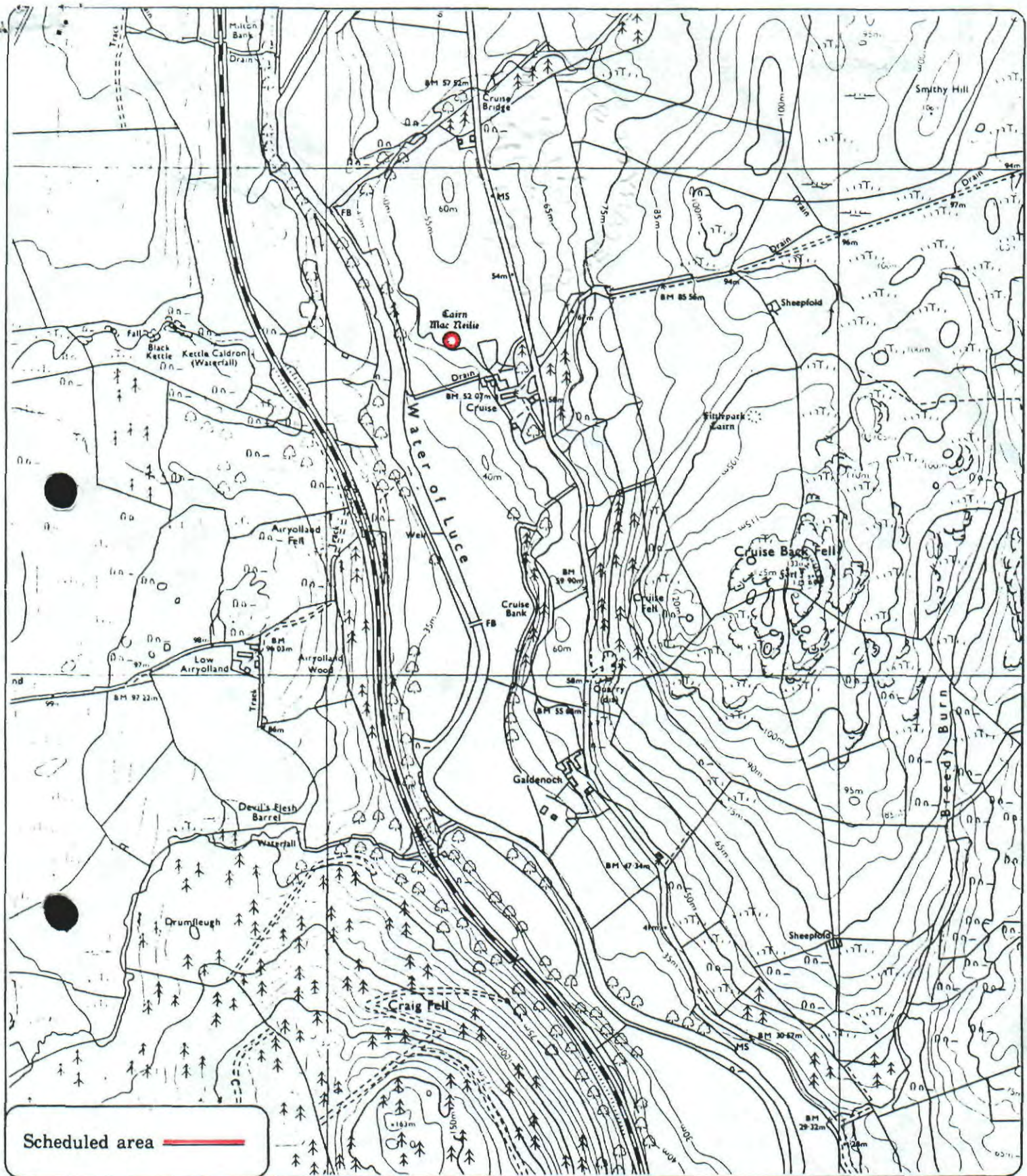

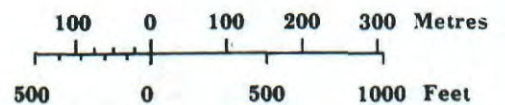
