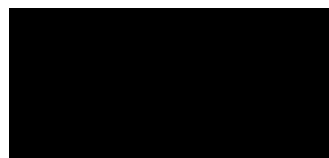

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Fettercairn House, burial mound 450m SW of comprises a burial mound of the late Neolithic or early Bronze Age, measuring c 22m in diameter and over 2m high. It will cover at least one burial, and other burials may lie beneath and within the mound. In addition the mound will cover an area of contemporary ground surface. The area to be *scheduled measures 60m in diameter, centred on the mound*, to include the mound and an area around in which features associated with its construction and use may survive. The modern fence and power line poles currently lying within the area are specifically excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fettercairn and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

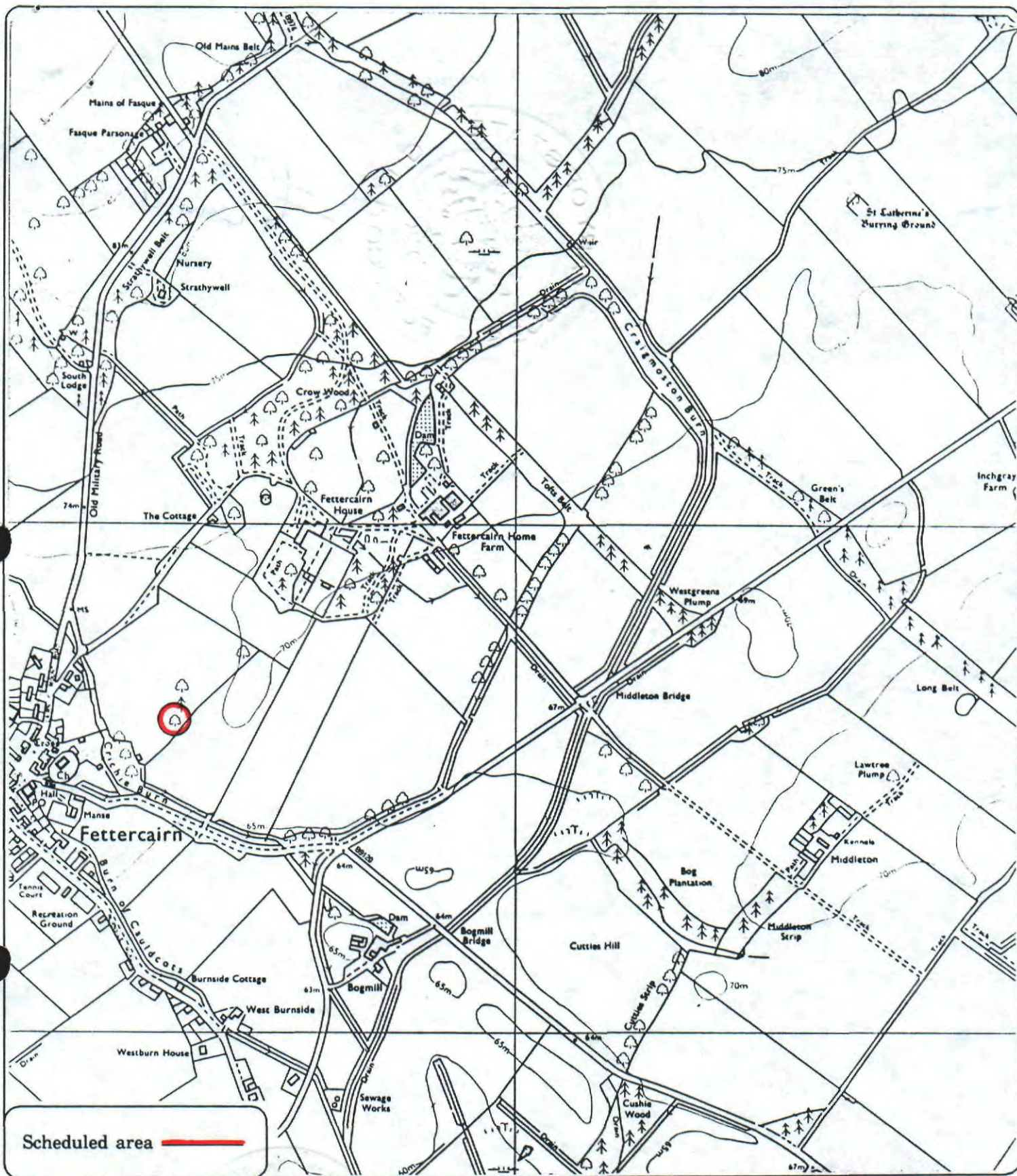

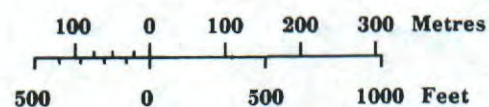
