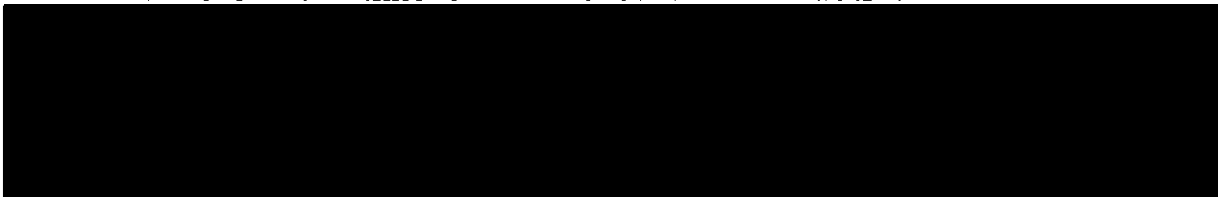

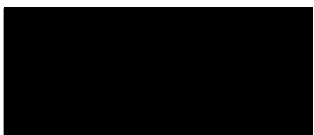
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as West Mulloch, settlement and field system 400m SE of comprises a settlement and field system of the period before the agricultural improvements. It comprises the remains of at least 8 sub-rectangular buildings, 5 stone walled enclosures and a kiln. The enclosures vary in size from 11m by 11m to 22m by 18m. The houses are in some cases multiple compartmented; the two best preserved measure 9.3m by 2.6m and 9.8m by 2.2m. The kiln is a massive stone structure, now largely infilled with stone. The area to be scheduled measures a maximum of 290m NE to SW by 220m transversely, to include the houses, the field system and the kiln, and an area around them in which traces of activity associated with their use may survive. The dry stone dykes which define the area to be scheduled are specifically excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parishes of Banchory-Ternan: Durris and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

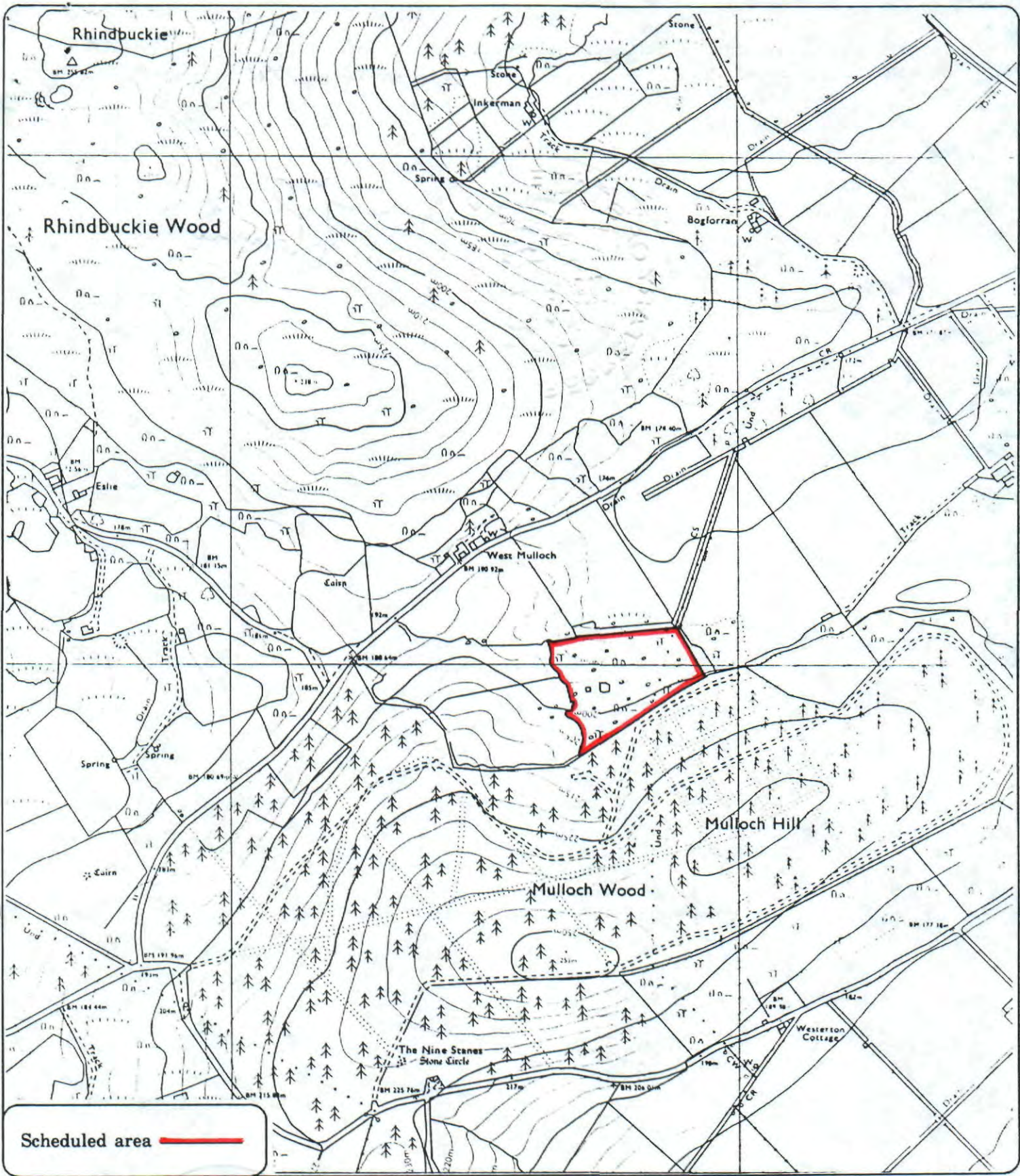

Scheduled area

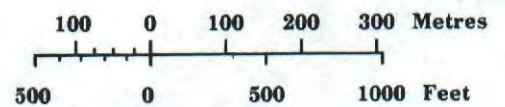
West Mulloch, settlement and field system 400m SE of
