ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Fettercairn House, burial mound 650m NNW of comprises a burial mound of the late Neolithic or early Bronze Age, measuring 17m in diameter and c 2m high. It will cover at least one burial and superficial digging in 1941 exposed a Beaker, a frequent accompaniment of secondary burials. It will also cover an area of contemporary ground surface. The area to be scheduled measures 60m in diameter, centred on the mound. The modern walls and road within the area are specifically excluded. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Fettercairn and the County of Kincardine as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

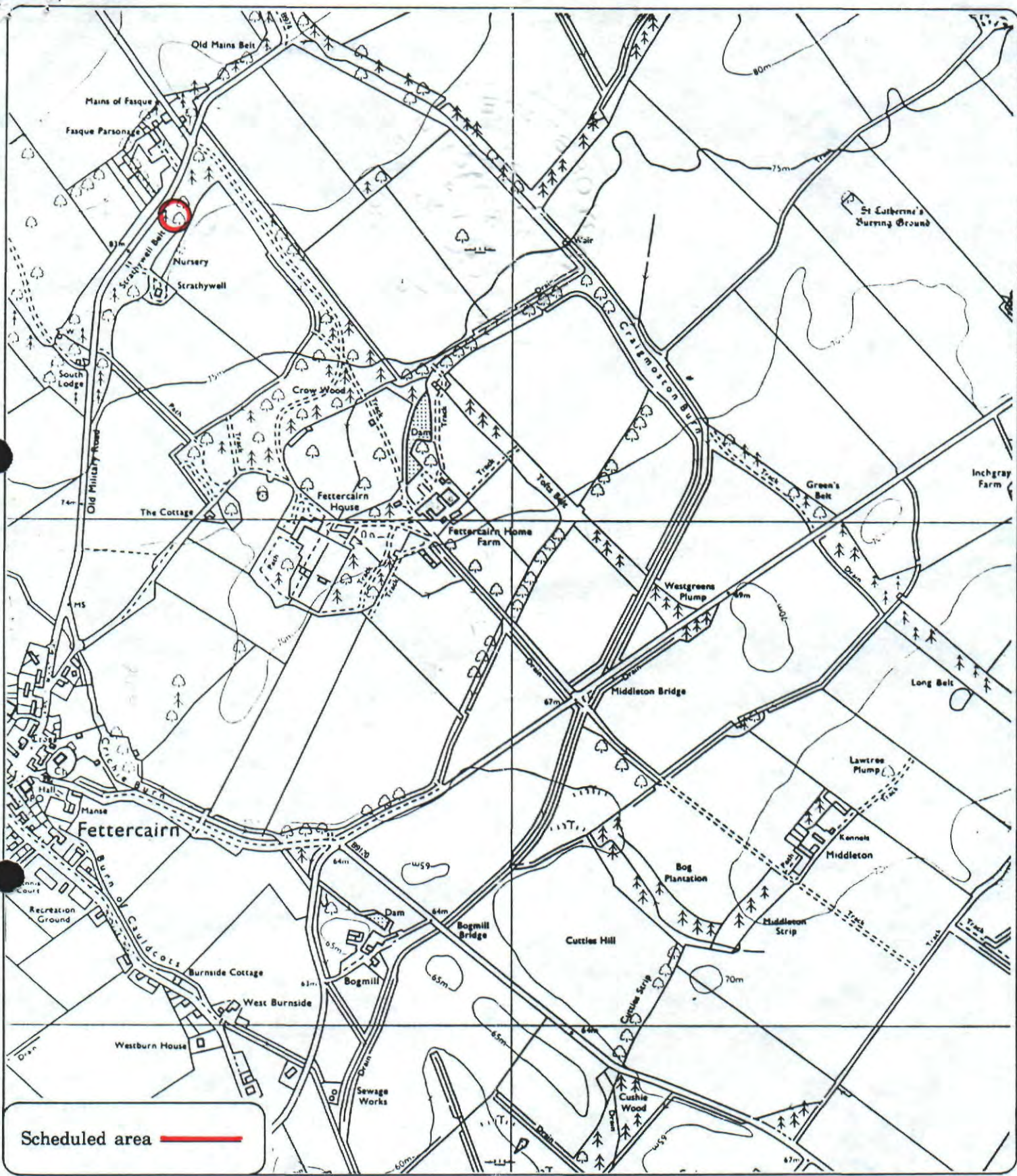


