THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Kildonan Castle comprises a ruined rectangular tower, some 6.7m N-S by 8.7m E-W, surviving at the NW corner some 11m-12m high. There were originally 3 stories, the first horizontally subdivided by a wooden mezzanine floor; the ground and first floors were barrel-vaulted, while the other floors were of wood. Remains of a rock-cut ditch survive 3m-4m E of the tower; there may have been a continuation of this on the N and W, but if so it is now filled in. The scheduled area comprises the tower and all above and below ground remains contained within an area extending for 6m from its walls on the NNW and WSW, and for 5m from its walls up to but not including the property appertaining to Castle House Cottage on the ENE, and up to the cliff edge on the SSE, measuring overall some 20m (E-W) by 15m (N-S). The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmory and the County of Bute as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

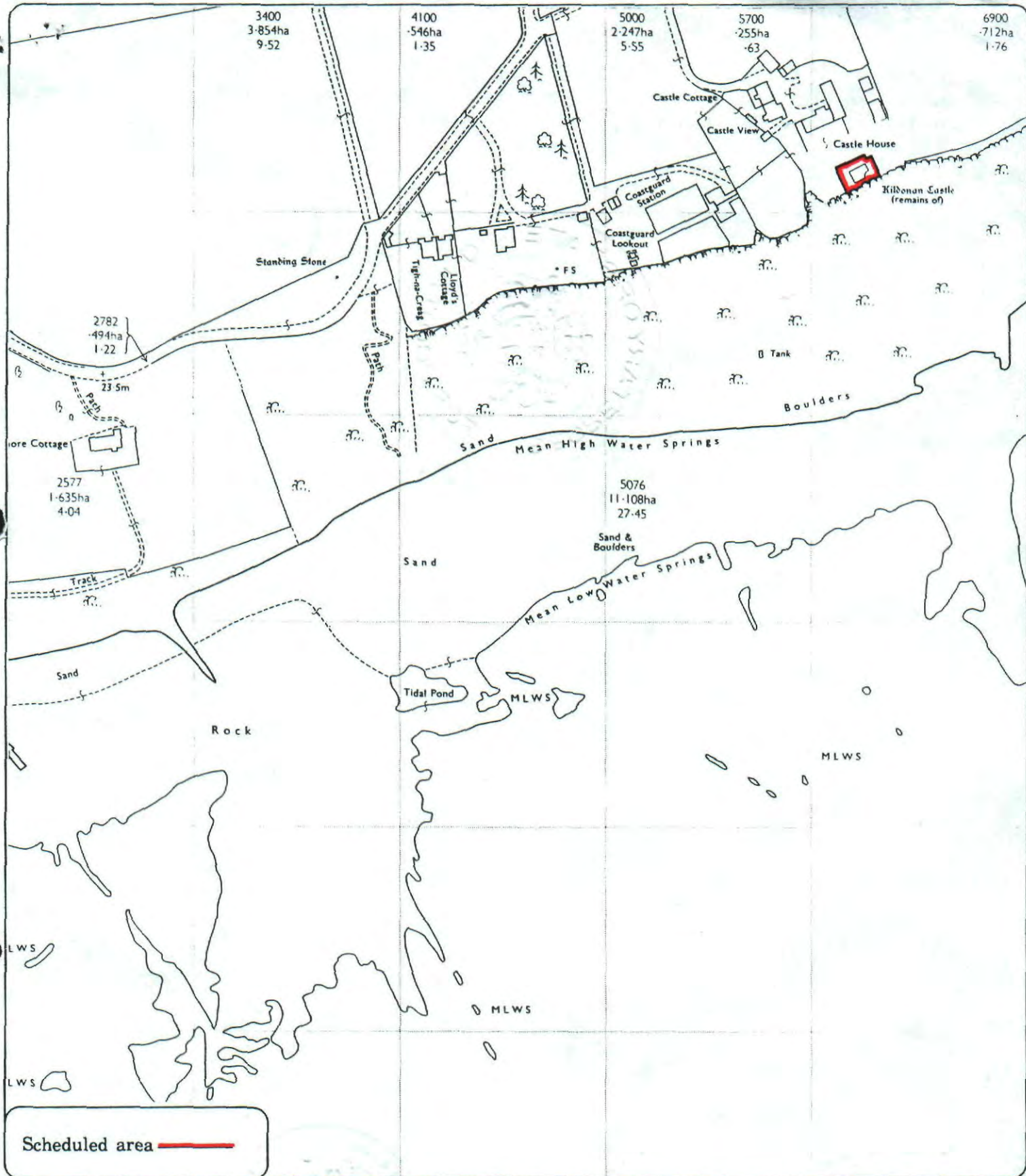
