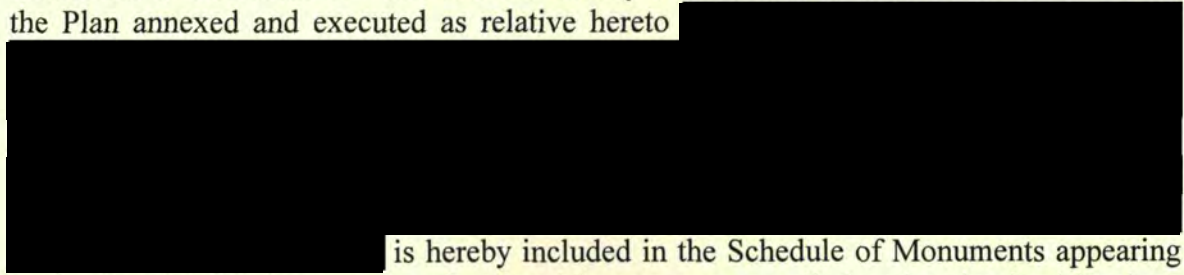


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979

The monument known as Beinn Ruilibreac, standing stones and enclosure 360m ESE of, Vatersay, comprises a standing stone and associated enclosure that are to be found in rough and rocky ground on the SE of Ben Rulibreac on Vatersay. The area to be scheduled is rectangular and measures 50m SW-NE by 30m transversely, to include the stone, enclosure, and an area around in which associated remains may survive. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Barra and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto



is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
