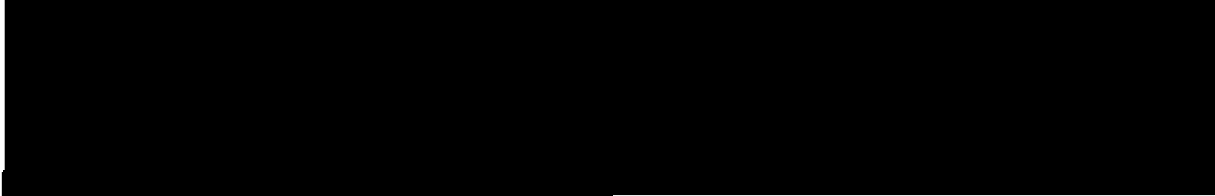

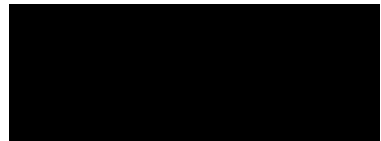
THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Buaille Riabhach, cairn and standing stones, Scalasaig, Colonsay comprises a D-shaped kerbed cairn, measuring some 3.6 by 3m and 0.3m high, with 2 standing stones set on the line of the kerb. The larger stone is 2.3m high and 1.8m in girth at the base; the smaller stone would be 1.15m high if it were vertical, and is 0.3m thick and 0.65m broad. A sword and dagger were excavated from the cairn in 1881 and removed from the site. The scheduled area includes the cairn and standing stones and an area extending for 5m from the outer face of the kerb. The monument, which lies in the Parishes of Colonsay and Oronsay and the County of Argyll as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

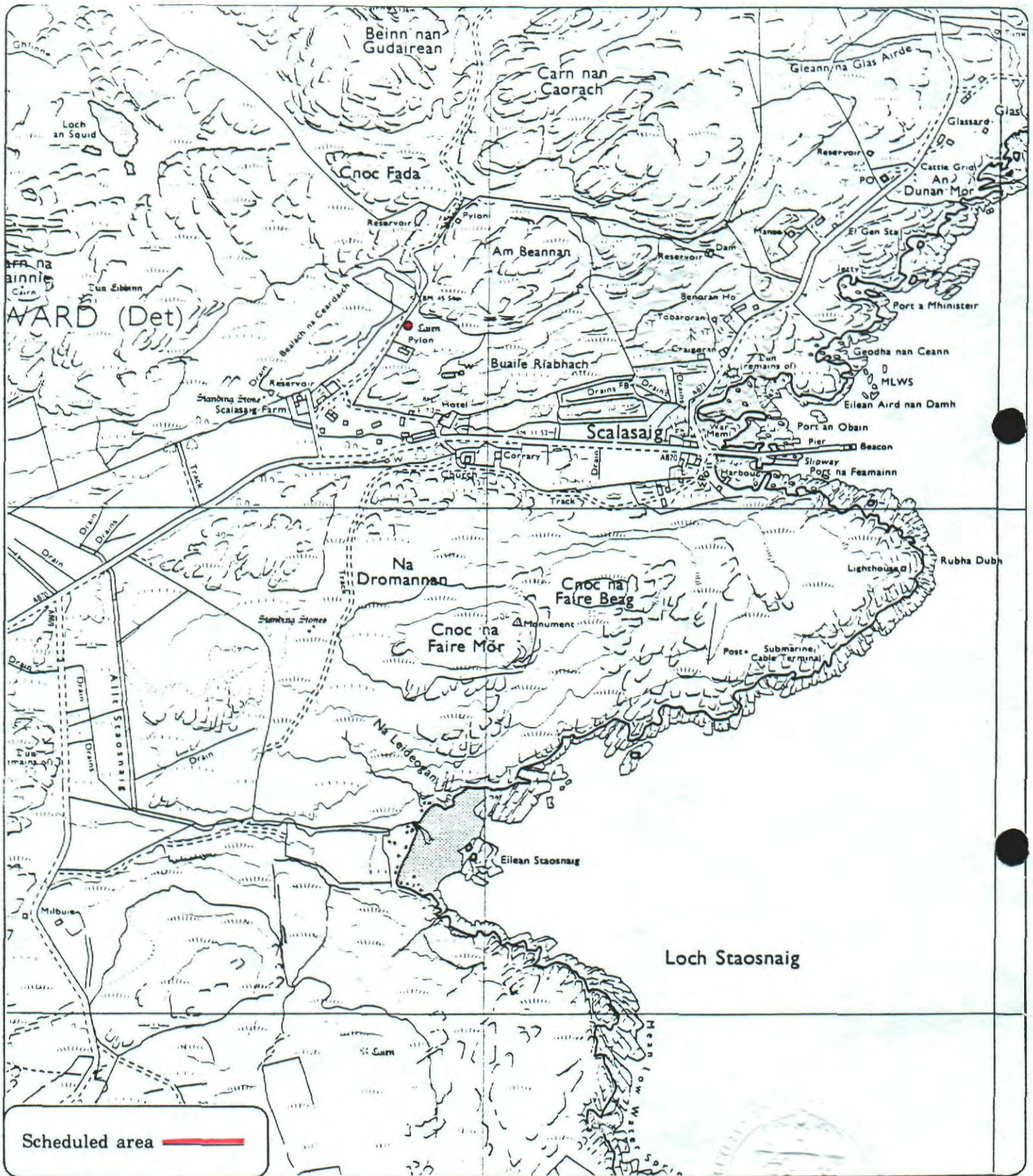

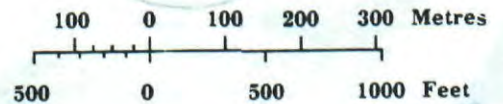
