THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979  
ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Foshigarry, settlement comprises the ruined recent croft buildings at Foshigarry which partially overlie an extensive Iron Age settlement, consisting of at least one large aisled house, two smaller round houses, four small sub-rectangular foundations and a souterrain. Although these known structures were excavated in the period 1914-19, sufficient remains of their structure, and of surrounding and underlying deposits which form a substantial mound, to suggest that further structures and much archaeological evidence is still concealed within the site. The area to be scheduled is defined by the coast on the NE side and by the base of the large mound on which the later buildings sit, an area extending 110m NW-SE by 85m NE-SW. The monument, which lies in the Parish of North Uist and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and



included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Secretary of State for Scotland to be of national importance compiled and maintained by him under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.
