



The monument known as Polnoon Castle comprises the remains of a late fourteenth century castle. The area to be scheduled is a quadrilateral which measures a maximum of 80m NE-SW by 50m NW-SE to include the castle and an area surrounding it which may contain evidence of activity relating to the monument. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Eaglesham and the County of Renfrew as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the

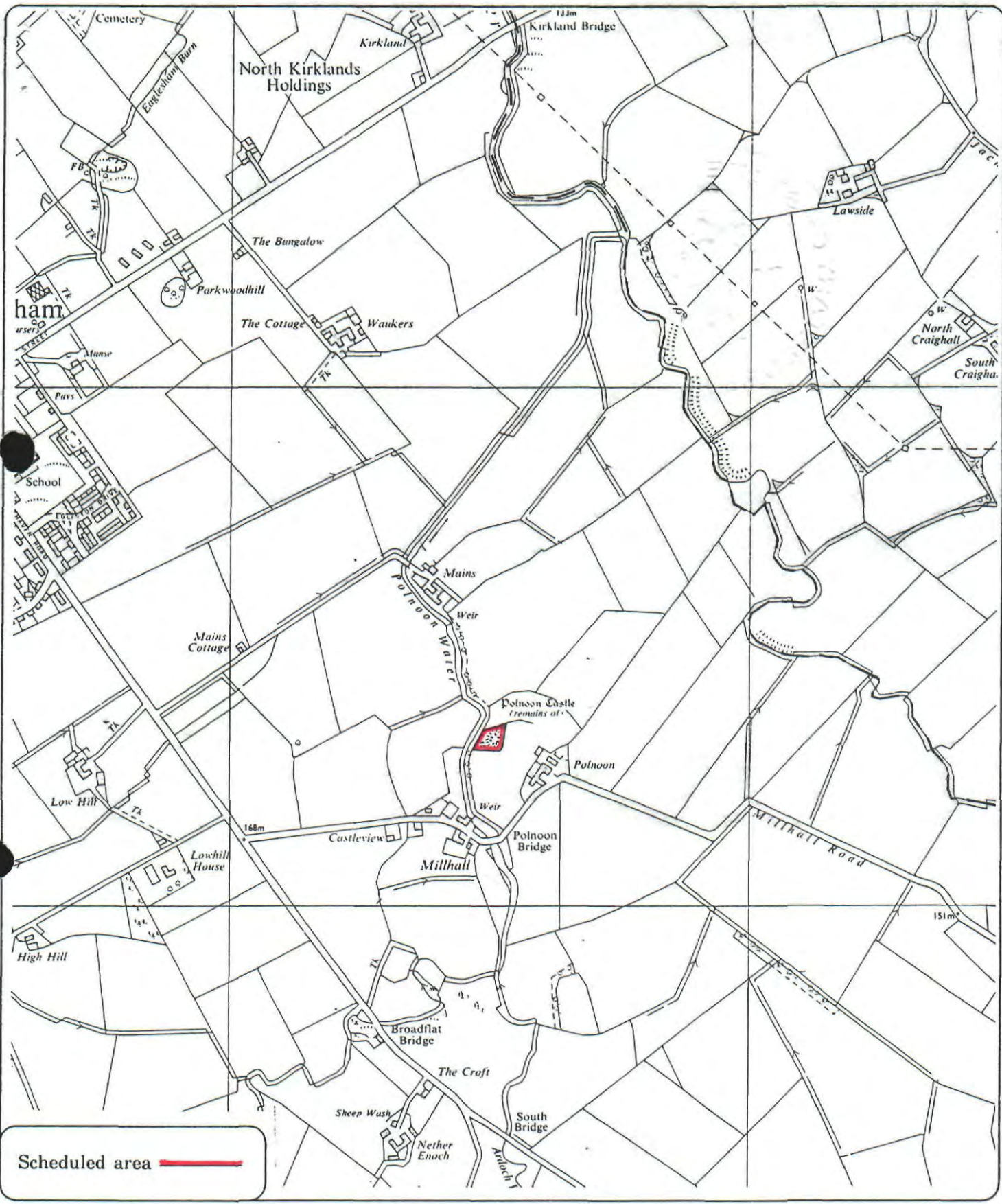




**Polnoon Castle**
