The monument known as High House of Edmonston, tower house comprises the remains of a fortified residence probably built during the middle of the fifteenth century. The area to be scheduled is irregular and measures a maximum of 40m N-S by 35m E-W, excluding the surrounding fence. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Biggar and the County of Lanark as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

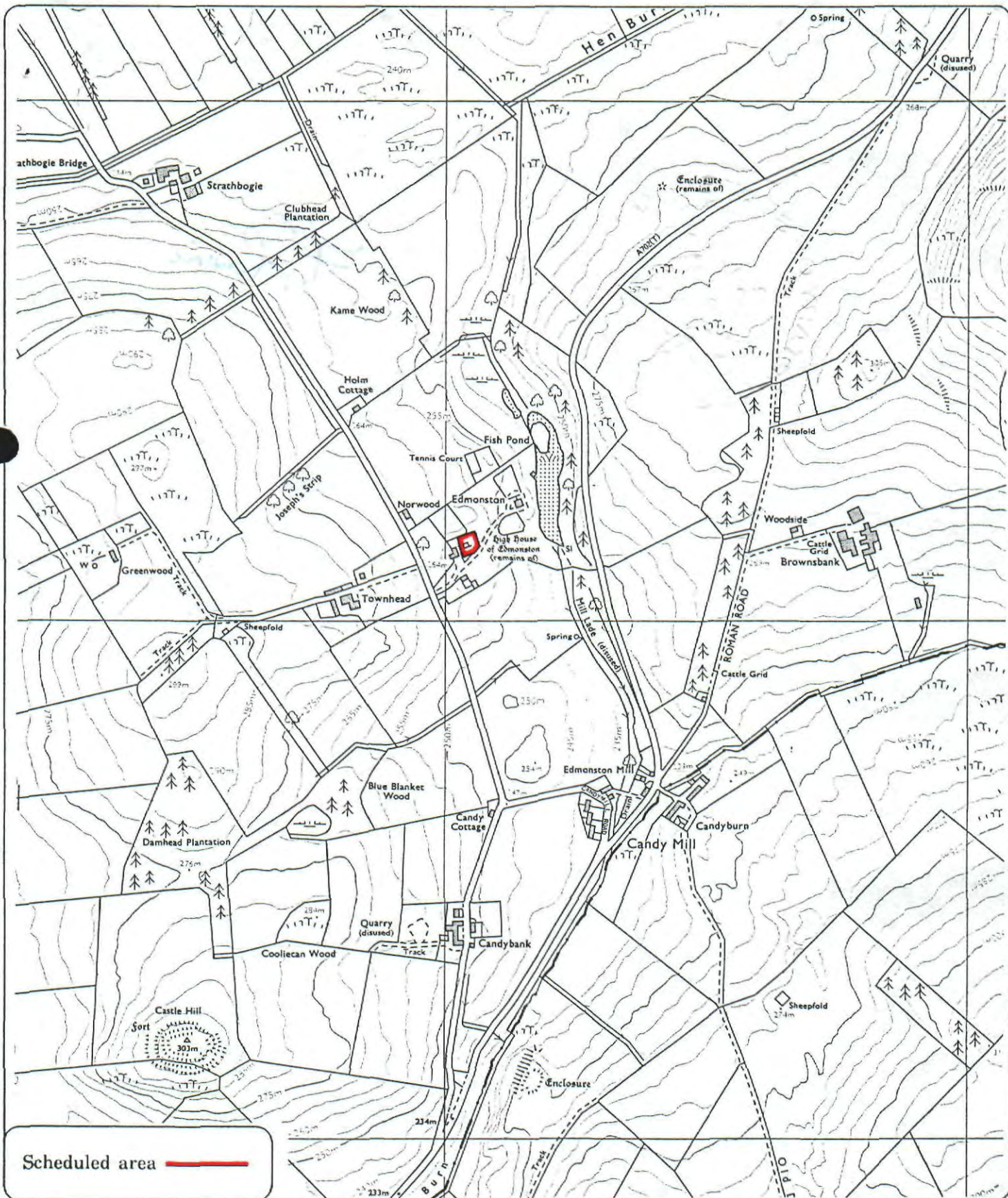

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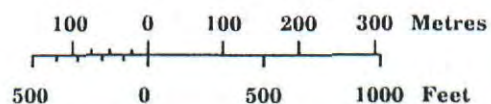
