


THE ANCIENT MONUMENTS AND ARCHAEOLOGICAL AREAS ACT 1979 5295

The entry in the Schedule of monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the above Act in respect of the monument known as **Caledonian Canal, Laggan Locks**, dated 13 April 1992 and recorded in the Division of the General Register of Sasines for the County of Inverness on 22 October 1992 is hereby in accordance with the provisions of section 1(5) of the above Act amended to specifically exclude the bothy and workshops situated at Laggan Locks.

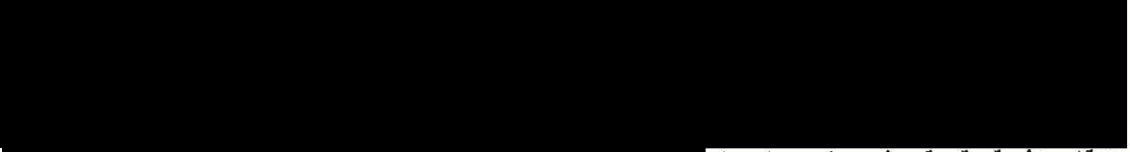

The monument known as Caledonian Canal, Laggan Locks comprises a pair of standard Caledonian Canal masonry lock chambers with associated working areas, including protective jetties projecting into Loch Lochy. It is situated at the NE end of the lock, and is partly on reclaimed ground. The area to be scheduled is irregular in shape, approximately 335m by 70m. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Kilmonivaig and the County of Inverness as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto and which forms part of the subjects

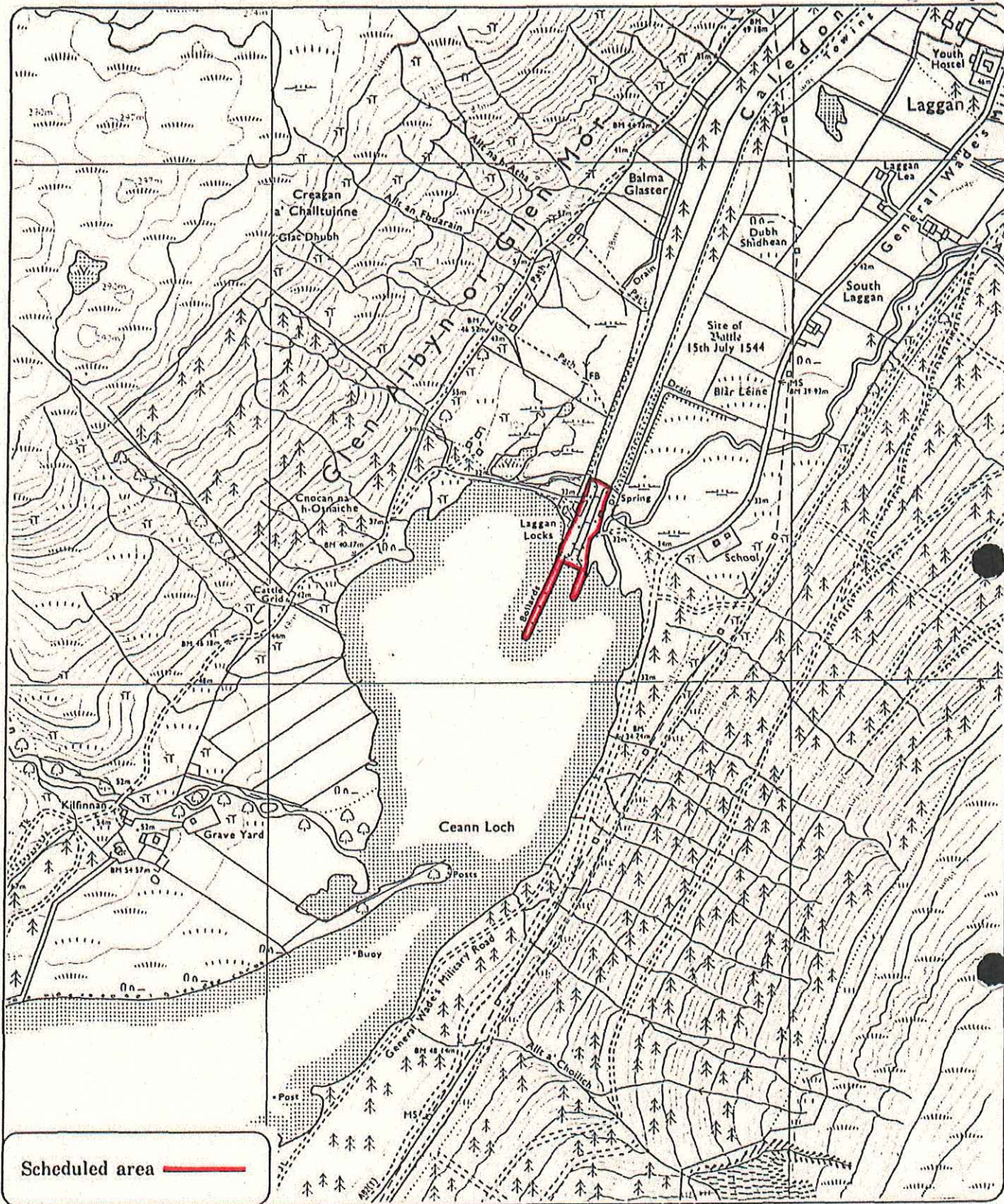
